Recently an effort was made to move the old Circuit Court records of Muhlenberg County to the State Archives at Frankfort. For the time being, at least, this has

been blocked by the local Bar Association.

At its meeting on August 6, the Muhlenberg County Genealogical Society discussed this matter to a considerable extent and a vote was taken to go on record as opposing such a move. A letter was prepared and signed by all members present; this is to be given to the Bar Association to be used in their efforts to keep the records in the County. It was also suggested, and included in the letter, that the Archives be invited to come to the County and microfilm the records, which microfilm could then be avilable to researchers in Frankfort.

At the same meeting another letter was prepared to be sent to County Judge/
Executive Robert Draper and the members of the Fiscal Court, suggesting that they
go to Russellville and make a study of the restoration of the old jail of Logan
County and the use that it is having as a place for keeping non-current Circuit
Court records. The same thing could be done with the old jail of Muhlenbeg County
and would give much space for the preservation of Muhlenberg County's non-current
Circuit and County Court records, at the same time having them at hand for the use
of the local Bar and for researchers who come here from all over the country to
trace family or other records of the past. We would like to recommend that as many
of our members as possible go to Russellville and see for themselves what has been
done and is being done towards the preservation of their old jail and their county
records. I'M sure you would find it interesting and instructive.
