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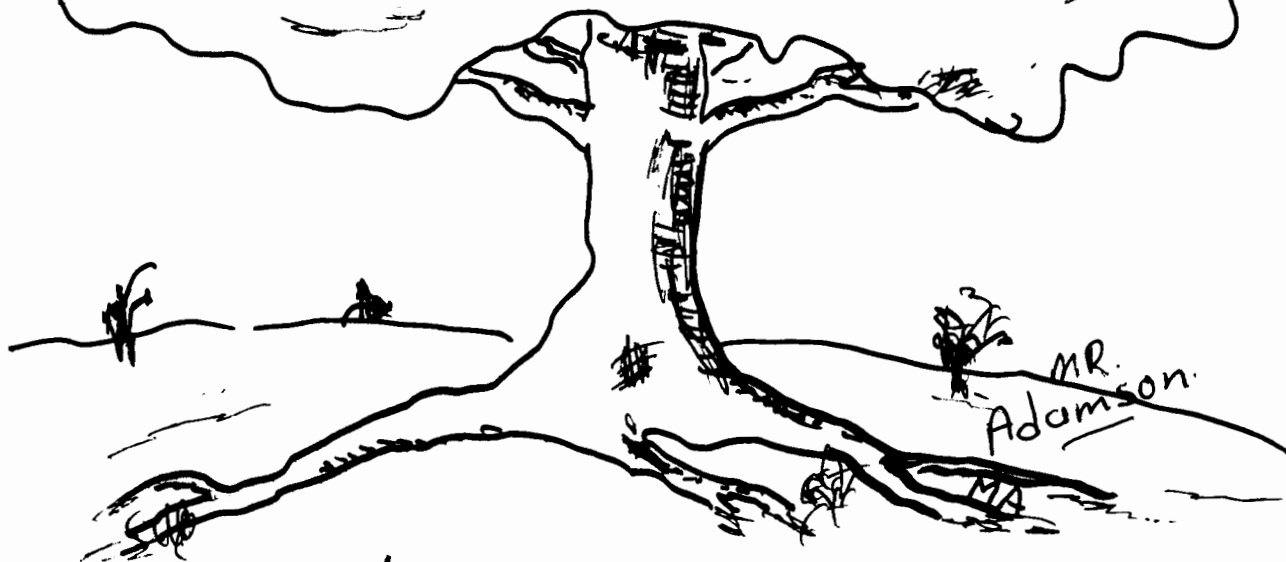

As we know Genealogy is family history. In ancestor hunting we strive for accuracy and completeness. When errors are revealed in research correction is sought for a true and accurate account of the history of our people.

Likewise, in recording the history of any organization, errors and/or omissions should be corrected early on. This is particularly applicable to any organization that delves into genealogical research and history as its reason for being. The Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society is typical - founded especially for that purpose. Member activities within the organization recorded in the media or elsewhere become history. Such information should be accurate and complete insofar as possible, with a minimal amount of errors.

In 1980 as newly elected Pres., Virginia Posey DeVries chose to honor Miss Lucille Scott by appointing her to be the Historian of the Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society. She has done an exceptional job considering the variety of organizational sources involved. However, cognizant of the importance of correcting any errors, she has asked me to undertake this job. As Past President and a Charter Member who has attended all meetings of our Society since its beginning, I agreed to do this. Therefore, such errors and/or omissions which have been brought to our attention are set forth hereinbelow, together with the corresponding corrections or clarifications relative thereto: (Reference is made to the Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society's By-Laws where applicable).

PAGE 4, PARA. 4 - Reads "By-Laws Committee, Virginia DeVries, Sue Evans and Beverly Wells".  
CORRECTION: - Should read: "By-Laws Committee, Sue Evans and Beverly Wells".

OMISSIONS: #1 - The So. Ky. Genealogical Society's By-Laws dated 1977 were amended early in 1981, with the following persons being appointed by the President to the By-Laws Committee: Eugenia Hayes, Betty Lyne, Wm. Neel Jackson, Ruva Haliburton and Mildred Collier. The Pres., Virginia Posey DeVries, served as an Ex-officio member without voting privileges. The membership had suggested amending these By-Laws and the amended By-Laws were unanimously adopted subsequently at a regular meeting.

Virginia Posey DeVries, the following 1982 officers were installed: Pres., Melvin Adamson; Vice-Pres., Era Stinson; Secy. Helen Lawrence; Treasurer, Wm. Neel Jackson. (Employment prevented Corres. Secy. Sue Hudnall from being present). Concluded historical Report.

## THE WORLEY FAMILY

The Worleys's of Warren and Butler County, Kentucky are descended from William Worley. He came to Warren County between 1810 and 1814 (the date of his marriage to Rosanna Likens). William was born around 1790-in Virginia, but the county of birth is not known. His parents are belived to be William and Anney Worley of Botetourt County, Virginia, but that has not been proven. Rosanna was a daughter of William Likens, and was also born in Virginia (about 1796). The Worley name was common in Pennsylvania and Virginia in the Eighteenth Century.

William and family lived in Warren County untill the early 1830's, when they moved to Butler County. At this time he was involved in several land transactions. He received a land grant of 100 acres on Green River in 1838. The 1840 Census listed William in Butler County. The children and grandchildren of William and Rosanna married into such families as; Allen, Colburn, Keown, Young, Likens, Renfrow, Raymer, James, Gary, Kessinger and other less common surnames of the area. At least two sons served in the Civil War (William and George). According to family legend, George may have died in the Andersonville (Georgia) Confederate Prison in 1864. William died in 1850 and his wife-Rosanna, died in 1859 (both in Butler County). Between 1850 and the 1880's James, William Jr., and Leander Worley had moved to Missouri. By the early 1900's nearly all of the Worleys of this area had migrated to the West (mostly to Missouri and Texas).

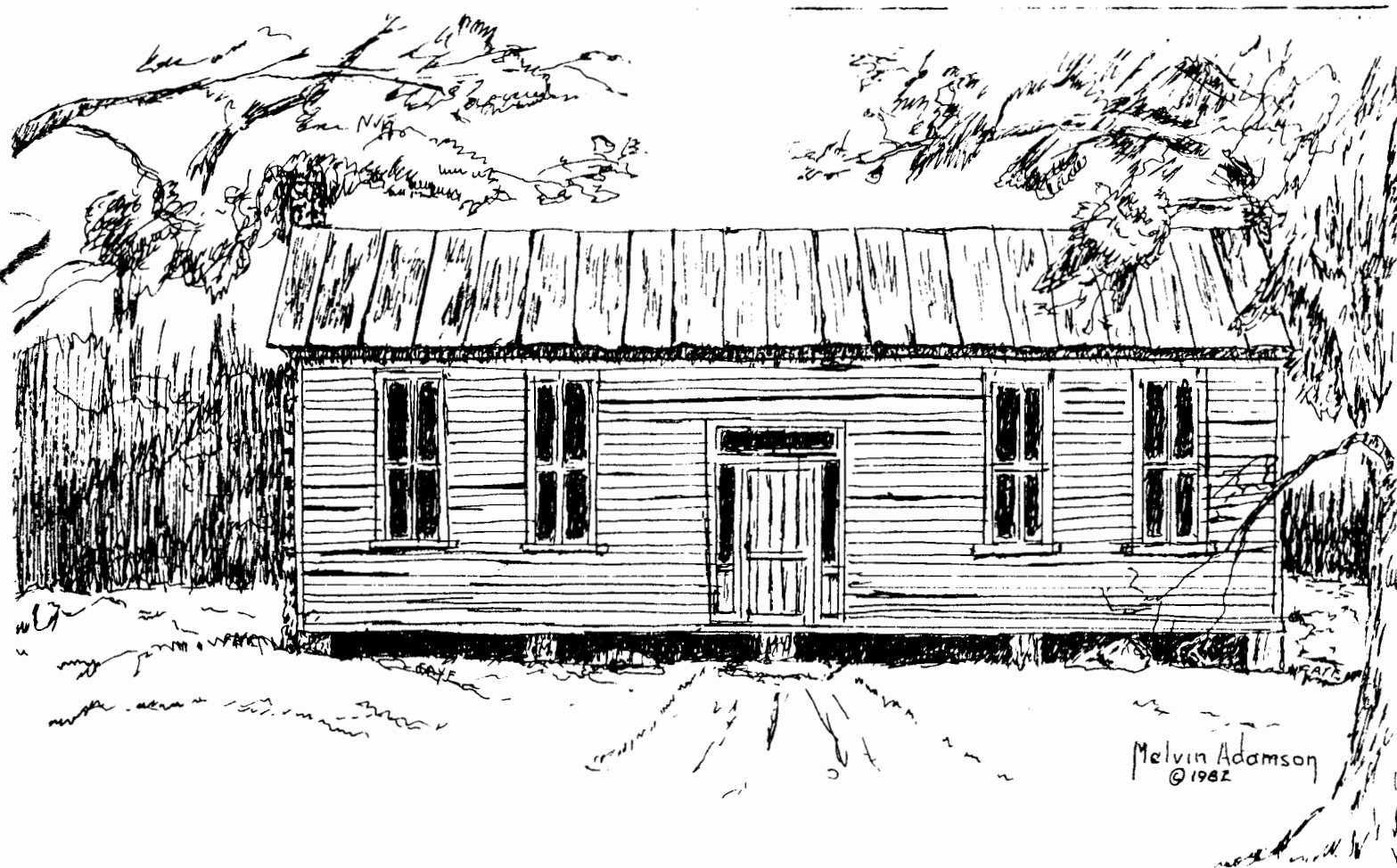

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The following history of the Burke Family was written by Arvilla Tabor, 1432 Parkhurst Drive, Bowling Green, KY. 42101 about her ancestors. The sketch of the Moulder home was made by SKGS President Melvin Adamson.



## TRIALS OF THE BURKE FAMILY

The BURKE name originated in Ireland. History gives information of "BURKES" in Dublin, Ireland and some think this to be our lineage, but this has not been proven by me.

The first of my BURKE family is as follows:

I James BURKE, imigrated with his parents from England to America at an unknown date. They settled on James River, Tidewater, Va. in 1740. He married Ann Moore, and raised a large family, owned a large plantation with many slaves.

II I descend from his son John BURKE who was born 1783 on James River, Va. At age 14 he migrated to Yadkin River Country, N.C., with an older brother and family. His brother was then killed by the Indians; John escaped, joined company with others and moved on to Tennessee where he took up the trade of a cobbler. Settling on War Trace Creek on Cumberland River near Gainsboro, Tn., he married Elizabeth Graves in 1811. They had 10 children: John Jr., b. 1812; Henry, 1815; Franklin, 1819; Carroll (a male), 1820; James W., 1822; Logan, 1824; Marion, 1825; Polly, 1826; Parasetta, and Elizabeth Lois BURKE. His wife Elizabeth Graves Burke died in Tennessee 1831. John Sr. married Jane Lamb as his second wife and their children were: Elvira, Annie, Jonas, Meta and Matilda. He died 1853 in Tn.

III I descend through his son James W. BURKE born April 14, 1822 on War Trace Creek, Gainsboro, Tn, who married Matilda Richmond March 1, 1838. They had five children: Elizabeth Lois, 1840; John R., 1841; Henry Thomas, 1843; James Marion, 1847; Benjamin Franklin, 1856. James W. and Matilda Richmond BURKE prospered on War Trace Creek until he signed bonds for a sherrif and some notes for merchants, which all defaulted. He (James) sent the money to the Bank, severals thousand dollars in cash by a well trusted neighbor, who was way-laid, killed and robbed. Again, James raised the money, took it himself to the Bank, with a guard, but it took their home to pay this for the second time.

After this they moved their family to Smith Co., Tn, on Dixon Creek. This also brought trouble for the BURKE family. As the Civil War occured and two of their sons and a son-in-law (Brooks Parker), all joined the Confederate Army with Morgan's Raiders. After serving time with them, Brooks Parker changed sides and joined the northern side. In a battle near Hartsville, Tn., he (Brooks Parker) was captured and imprisoned by the Rebels.

IV Grandma (Elizabeth Lois Burke Parker) and her small son, James Marion Parker, along with Grandma's mother, Matilda Richmond Burke, rode in a spring wagon to the jail where her husband Brooks Parker was being held as a deserter from Morgan's Raiders.

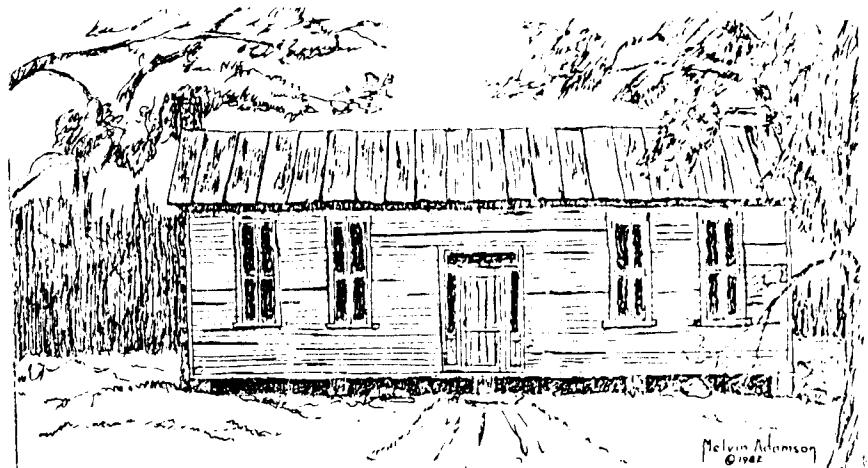
The officer in charge gave Grandma (Elizabeth Lois Parker) permission to be with her husband until time for him to be shot. Brooks, with his small son James in his arms and Grandma (Elizabeth Lois) by his side, descended the long stairway. As they stepped on to the ground, the officer asked Grandma if she wished to see her husband killed and she said no. She then took James her son from her husband and started back up the stairs when she heard the deadly shot that killed her young husband. She was granted claim to his body and it was removed to her father's farm for burial.

The Burke family then soon left Tennessee; James W. and Matilda Richmond Burke brought their children and grandson to Kentucky, settling three miles south of Smiths Grove in Warren County, KY.

Later in 1866 Grandma married a second time to Jacob Moulder. They bought a small farm near her father's land and built a small log cabin. In about 1871 they started on a new log house for their growing family. By this time they, of course, had James Marion Parker, son of the first marriage, plus the Moulder children: John Victor, 1867; George Byron, 1869; Sarah Matilda, 1871; Jacob Valentine, 1872; David Franklin, 1875; Mary Daisy Hall, 1878; and Herbert Spencer, 1880.

The infant daughter Sarah Matilda, born and died in 1871, was the first person buried at the Cedar Grove Cemetery now known as the "Moulder's Graveyard." The cemetery is just beyond the lily pond that bloomed so lovely many years ago, but, now has been cleaned so well that the lilies are a thing of the past. From the lily pond there are two rows of beautiful tall pine trees to drive between on the way up to the cemetery.

Our family has now all left the Old Homeplace of Jacob and Elizabeth Lois Burke Parker Moulder. Several descendants live in the Kepler and Three Forks Communities until this date.

Samuel Greathouse is listed on 1850 Warren County, Kentucky federal census (on page 248, dwelling #837, family #837):

Samuel Greathouse, Sr., 82, born Maryland; Susannah Greathouse age 72, born Virginia; Warren Greathouse age 30, born Kentucky.

The census was taken in August, 1850. Susannah Greathouse is listed in Vital Statistics of Warren Co., Ky. 1852-1862, she

died 26 October 1854 at age 74. She was a widow. Samuel died sometime between August, 1850 and October, 1854. Samuel and

Susannah Greathouse lived in Warren Co., Ky. from at least 1799 to the time of their deaths. Samuel is listed on 1799 tax

records for Warren County, Kentucky along with John Greathouse, John Greathouse, Jr., Elizabeth Greathouse and Harmon

Greathouse (their relationship to Samuel and Susannah unknown). The John Greathouse, Sr. listed may be Susannah's father.

There is a reference in the History of Kentucky Baptists to Samuel Greathouse and it states he was of German extraction and

a native of Maryland. He emigrated to Northern Kentucky, where he married his cousin, Susan Greathouse, and became one of

the early settlers of Warren County, Kentucky. Samuel was a preacher in the Green River Association of Baptist Church affilia

tion, for many years. He performed hundreds of marriages in Warren County. Samuel became a preacher after becoming alarmed

about the safety of his soul because of the following circumstances: At a house-raising, he was carrying up one of the corners

of the building, when a fork, with which the men on the ground pushed up the logs, split open and allowed the log to roll back,

by which two men were instantly killed. "What would have become of my soul if I had been one of those men?" soliloquized Mr.

Greathouse. This was not long after the beginning of the 19th century. Mr. Greathouse was soon afterwards baptized and

entered into the constitution of Bays Fork Church, located about eight miles east of Bowling Green, Ky. He was soon afterward

set apart to the ministry. (This information from page 114 of History of Kentucky Baptists, Green River Association, by

J. H. Spencer, Volume 2.) The historical table of the Gaspar River Association of Kentucky Baptists lists Samuel Greathouse

as giving the sermon in 1812 in Providence, Warren Co., Ky.; being the moderator in 1813 in Bays Fork, Warren Co., Ky.; and

giving the sermon in 1818 in Walton's Creek, Ohio Co., Ky. (Information from book on Gaspar River Association of Kentucky

Baptists.) Samuel Greathouse obtained a land grant in Warren County on 28 August 1799 consisting of 200 acres of land, it

states "certificate #2021 granted by commissioners in 1798 agreeably to an act for encouraging granting relief to soldiers".

The Warren County, Kentucky tax list for 1799 shows that on 6 June Samuel Greathouse owned 200 acres located west of the Big

Barren River. Samuel Greathouse is listed on Kentucky tax lists for 1800 in Warren Co., Ky. in the book (2nd census of

Kentucky). Samuel is listed in 1810 Warren Co., Ky. federal census, in age group 26-45 years with 3 males under age 10;

1 male age 10-16 and 3 females under age 10; 1 female 10-16 years and 1 female age 26-45 years. There is also a William

Greathouse aged over 45 years and an Isaac Greathouse age 26-45 (both possibly Samuel's brothers), with their families.

On the 1820 Warren Co., Ky. federal census, Samuel Greathouse is listed in age group 45 & over; with 5 sons under age 10;

1 age 10-16 and 2 age 16-26; with 1 female under age 10, 1 age 10-16, 2 age 16-26 and his wife age 26-45. Also listed are

Levi Greathouse age 26-45; Isaac Greathouse age 26-45; and William Greathouse age 26-45 and their families. On the 1830

Warren County, Ky. federal census Samuel Greathouse is listed on page 109 age 60-70, with 3 sons age 10-15; 1 age 15-20, 2 ag

20-30 and with 1 female in family age 5-10; 1 age 10-15 and 1 age 20-30; his wife was age 50-60. The only other Greathouse

family listed is Isaac Greathouse age 30-40 with one daughter under age 5 and his wife age 20-30. (This Isaac is Samuel's son)

The 1840 Warren Co., Ky. federal census lists Samuel Greathouse age 60-70, with 1 son 10-15, 1 son 15-20, 1 son 20-30 and 1 daughter 15-20 and his wife 60-70. There is a John Greathouse age 30-40 with his family listed; Isaac Greathouse age 40-50 with his family listed and a Joseph Greathouse age 30-40 (it is believed this is an error - should be Josiah Greathouse, not Joseph.) On the 1850 federal census for Warren Co., Ky. Samuel Greathouse is listed as age 82, his wife Susannah age 72, and living with them Warren age 30. Other Greathouse families in Warren Co., Ky. on 1850 census are:

- 1) #783, #783 John Greathouse 40, Catherine 36, Leonard T. 11, William R. 9, Isaac C. 7, Sarah F. 5, Susan E. 4, Christine A. 2. (John is the son of Samuel and Susannah Greathouse.)

The 1860 Warren Co., Ky. federal census lists Josiah Greathouse on page 73, #676, #676 - Josiah is 58, farmer, value \$8,440, \$1,320; Sarah 41; Thomas 23; Elijah 21; Charles 17; William 14; Louisa 10; Samuel 5; Julie Ann 1.

On page 62, #579, #579 is Samuel Greathouse 48, Pollie 36 with their ten children ages 1 to 18.

The 1870 Warren Co., Ky. federal census lists Josiah Greathouse #159, #159 - Josiah age 67, value \$2,400; \$1,000; Sarah 51; Samuel J. 15; Julia 10; Charles 27; William 23.

Family #132, Dwelling #132 is E. H. Greathouse age 31, value \$1,500; Mary J. 25; Robert A. 7; Lafayette S. 5; Alice 3; F.R. 1

Family #138, Dwelling #138 is B. Greathouse 50, \$1,500; \$300; Sarah A. 34; Jane E. 11; Charles T. 9; Mary E. 5; George I.

Family #160, Dwelling #160 is Thomas Greathouse 31; E. 35; John 6; V.F. 3; Charles S. 2; Elavese? 6/12 months.

They all lived in Green Hill, Goshen Precinct, Kentucky.

1880 Warren County, Ky. federal census shows Josiah Greathouse on page 23, in Goshen District, #203, #223 - Josiah is age 77; Sarah 60; Thomas 40; Charles 12, grandson living them.

Other Greathouse families in Warren Co. in 1880 are headed by: Charles Greathouse age 39; William B. Greathouse age 33; Barry Greathouse age 60; Lucian Greathouse age 29; L. S. Greathouse age 33; S. B. Greathouse age 68; S. A. Greathouse age 39; Jesse Greathouse age 44; John P. Greathouse age 15 and Thomas Greathouse age 5 are nephews of Sydney Lowe living with Sydney age 32 and his mother Nancy Lowe age 71 in the village of Oakland, Ky.

Elijah Greathouse and his family moved to Butler County, Ky. after 1870 and before 1880 when they appear on Butler Co., Ky. federal census living in Mining City, Ky.: Elijah on page 16, #125, #131 - Elijah age 41; Mary J. 36; Robert A. 17; Lafayette S. 16; Alice 14; Dolly V. 9; Franklin P. 5; Frances M. 5; James E. 5/12 months.

On the 1900 federal census for Butler County, Ky. Elijah Greathouse is listed in District 3 - Elijah H. born January 1839 age 61; Dollie born August 1872 age 27; Frank P. born November 1874 age 25; James E. born January 1880 age 20; Ellie born March 1884 age 16. Lafayette S. Greathouse born March 1865 age 35 is living in District 3 with Belle born June 1866 age 33; Joseph M. born April 1887 age 13; Samuel J. born February 1889 age 11; Herschel G. born April 1891 age 9; John born January 1893 age 7; Herbert born July 1895 age 4; Eunice born October 1888 age 2. Also living in Butler Co. is Robert Greathouse age 37 and his family (Robert is brother of Lafayette.)

As we know Genealogy is family history. In ancestor hunting we strive for accuracy and completeness. When errors are revealed in research correction is sought for a true and accurate account of the history of our people.

Likewise, in recording the history of any organization, errors and/or omissions should be corrected early on. This is particularly applicable to any organization that delves into genealogical research and history as its reason for being. The Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society is typical - founded especially for that purpose. Member activities within the organization recorded in the media or elsewhere become history. Such information should be accurate and complete insofar as possible, with a minimal amount of errors.

In 1980 as newly elected Pres., Virginia Posey DeVries chose to honor Miss Lucille Scott by appointing her to be the Historian of the Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society. She has done an exceptional job considering the variety of organizational sources involved. However, cognizant of the importance of correcting any errors, she has asked me to undertake this job. As Past President and a Charter Member who has attended all meetings of our Society since its beginning, I agreed to do this. Therefore, such errors and/or omissions which have been brought to our attention are set forth hereinbelow, together with the corresponding corrections or clarifications relative thereto: (Reference is made to the Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society's By-Laws where applicable).

## THE WORLEY FAMILY

The Worleys's of Warren and Butler County, Kentucky are descended from William Worley. He came to Warren County between 1810 and 1814 (the date of his marriage to Rosanna Likens). William was born around 1790-in Virginia, but the county of birth is not known. His parents are belived to be William and Anney Worley of Botetourt County, Virginia, but that has not been proven. Rosanna was a daughter of William Likens, and was also born in Virginia (about 1796). The Worley name was common in Pennsylvania and Virginia in the Eighteenth Century.

William and family lived in Warren County untill the early 1830's, when they moved to Butler County. At this time he was involved in several land transactions. He received a land grant of 100 acres on Green River in 1838. The 1840 Census listed William in Butler County. The children and grandchildren of William and Rosanna married into such families as; Allen, Colburn, Keown, Young, Likens, Renfrow, Raymer, James, Gary, Kessinger and other less common surnames of the area. At least two sons served in the Civil War (William and George). According to family legend, George may have died in the Andersonville (Georgia) Confederate Prison in 1864. William died in 1850 and his wife-Rosanna, died in 1859 (both in Butler County). Between 1850 and the 1880's James, William Jr., and Leander Worley had moved to Missouri. By the early 1900's nearly all of the Worleys of this area had migrated to the West (mostly to Missouri and Texas).
