Call for Nominations; Staff Council Special Election

Attention WKU Staff:

We need your help to fill several vacancies on the WKU Staff Council. The council has recently voted to increase the number of positions on the council to increase the representation of our current staff as well as regional campuses. As a result, we have a number of open seats on the council which we will fill with a special election. The following is a table of these vacancies:
