As soon as this can be proof-read and an index prepared, it will go to the printer and, hopefully, be ready for sale by mid-1983. A transcription of the 1880 census is already on hand and typing on it will begin very soon.

ANOTHER PUBLICATION: Mrs. Norma Metcalf, secretary to MCGS member, Bill Donan, has been copying the minute book for the Muhlenberg County Court of Quarter Sessions. This record extends from 1799 to 1804, after which that court went out of existence and the Circuit Court came into being. This record should make an interesting and valuable genealogical publication when it is completed.

In the last issue of The Heritage you were informed that the Harbin Memorial Library in Greenville had been given \$5,000.00 with which to buy genealogical research materials. You will be glad to know that some \$3,500.00 worth of books and a number of additional census records have been received, with some of them having already been cataloged and placed on the shelves. Others are on order, including the 1910 census for Muhlenberg County and all of the adjoining counties. It is hoped that all outstanding orders will have been received by the end of December.

Recently the Harbin Memorial Library has been able to secure photo copies of some church records of the Cave Spring Baptist Church. These cover the period, roughly, from 1841 to 1900, with some gaps in dates. The originals are in bad condition, so it is possible that some pages have been lost through the years. There are several membership lists which will enable researchers to pinpoint a general area of residence for some early family members. Cave Spring is one of the older churches in Muhlenberg, having been first established in 1806, with the name "Cana" and with a membership of 18 persons who had been released as members of Hazel Creek. It is not known when it took the name it now bears; it apparently has some rough times during its earliest years.

In 1981 a box was found in the office of the Muhlenberg County Court Clerk, which contained birth records for the years 1906 to 1911. There is no way of knowing just how complete these records are. Some of them were signed by the doctor who attended the birth, but that is not generally true. Some of them are very difficult to read; others are clear. We herewith publish the records from the first two sheets, which are a mixture of 1906 and 1907 records. The entries are under twelve headings, as follows: (1) Date; (2) Name of child; (3) Sex; (4) Born Alive or Dead; (5) Place of Birth; (6) Name of Father; (7) Name of Mother; (8) Maiden Name of Mother; (9) White, Black or Mulatto; (10) Birthplace of Father; (11) Birthplace of Mother; (12) Remarks. It was regretable that more members -- and visitors -- were not in attendance at the December meeting of the Society to hear Mrs. Marian Hammers tell of some of her experiences in genealogy. Almost everyone doing research on Muhlenberg families owes her a debt of gratitude for her work in copying tombstones, abstracting will books (1799-1877) and transcribing Muhlenberg census records (1850-60-70-80). Her discussion was helpful and very interesting. As noted elsewhere, copying of her 1870 census has been completed and work on the 1880 census will start early in 1983.

In the last two issues of The Heritage for 1982 we printed the names and reel-page numbers for persons listed in the microfilm census record for Logan County, for 1810. Starting with this issue, we are doing the same for those people listed in the 1820 census of Logan. There is a considerable connection between families of Logan and Muhlenberg Counties, so the listing should be of help to many researchers. In order to get the family records, the interested person will have to examine the microfilm for the data.

Mrs. Carol Brown has located a most interesting book. It is a record of deaths beginning in 1923 and extending to 1960 and for the most part it seems to be of people who lived in western Muhlenberg County or Eastern Hopkins County. In addition to the name and date, it usually has the age of the individual. It was kept by Mr. W. F. Hunter, who, among other things, drove a hearse for an undertaker in White Plains. That fact may account for his interest in recording these deaths. In a few instances there are added comments, which will be included in our listing; we will not include, however, the deaths of people, recognizably not of this area, for example F. D. Roosevelt.
