Bessie Fayne, of Crab Orchard, Ky., Apr. 1896; children--Mrs. Josephine Lowman, Elizabeth, Henry Hardin. Took charge, 1892, of Southern Normal Sch. and Bowling Green Bus. U., then pvt. instn. enrolling only 78 students in 1 yr; has given entire time to it since then; now known as Western Ky. State Teachers Coll. (enrolling more than 4,000 students), of which is now pres. President College Heights Foundation. Member State Educational Comm. and the Exec. Council. Methodist. Democrat.
