Since my interest is mostly south central Kentucky, I have taken the
liberty and the time to go through the 213 pages of this historical and
genealogical help and have condensed those items which are of interest to
this area. I felt this necessary since the book was not indexed.

This paper was prepared for no other purpose than as a guide for
me, as a Librarian of Kentucky materials and Genealogical materials.

The reader will forgive me if I have overlooked items of interest
which might pertain to this area. However, those items mentioned in the
book which I remember from earlier research or those names which I have
encountered in my six years as librarian at the Weldon Library are listed.

It is hoped that the materials contained herein will motivate or
contribute in some small way those researchers interested in the history
of this area.

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How to use the KEY TO DATES OF ACTS :

To the left of each entry there is a volume and page number. Turn back to the Key to Dates of Acts and find the volume number and page number and to the left will be found the date and session.

For example: Dooley, Moses lists Vol 3 Page 103 . Turning back to the key we find that Vol 3 page 103 would be found in the 1803 November Session of Kentucky Acts since 1803 November Session covers pages 101-165 which would include page 103.
