c. Robert Teske, of the Center for Intercultural and Folk Studies, has been elected to fill the unexpired term of Senator for that department that was created by the retirement of Ken Clarke.

d. At this writing, the vacancy in Military Science created by the transfer of Major Billy Pearson has not been filled.
