# 1975-76 Western Kentucky University Women's Basketball



## 1975-76 OUTLOOK

Second-year coach Carol Hughes may be overly pessimistic about the outlook for her 1975-76 squad. If there is a reason, it could go back to 1974-75.

Last season, Hughes had an optimistic outlook toward what she felt was a solid team. But the squad ended the year with a disappointing 3-14 record.

Things really are looking better than last year, despite Hughes' reluctance to come right out and say it. For one thing, only four members of last year's team were able to make the squad this year.



Given scholarships with which to recruit for the first time, Hughes landed some outstanding high school and junior college basketball players.

"We're hoping to go from rags-to-riches," she said. "We hope we have out-recruited everybody else, but we have to wait and see."

"But like last season, we are new and young," said Hughes. "Around 70 per cent of our squad is made up of either freshmen or sophomores and we have no seniors. But we have more people with experience from high school ball and are much taller than last year."

The returning players are junior Brenda Chapman and sophomores Teresa Condit, Linda Howard and Susan Porter. Condit was the leading scorer last season with 12.5 points a game.

The outstanding newcomers from the high school ranks are Donna Doellman, Pam Kordenbrock, Beth Lane and Isabelle Spriggs. Outstanding junior college transfers are Daphne Easterling and Emily Penny.

Other members of this year's squad are sophomore Linda Davis and freshmen Suzette Price, Joni Taylor and Matilda Willis.

### Coach CAROL HUGHES

Dr. Carol Hughes, who is entering her second year as head coach of the women's basketball squad at Western Kentucky, isn't lacking coaching experience.

The native of Birmingham, Ala., has a great deal of coaching background in both the high school and college ranks. She has been in the coaching spotlight since 1969.

Before coming to Western, Dr. Hughes coached the women's basketball and men's tennis teams at Ft. Lewis College in Durango, Colo. She coached both squads to second-place conference finishes.

Before going to Ft. Lewis, Dr. Hughes spent two years at Weber State College in Ogden, Utah. There, she coached the women's volleyball, softball and basketball squads. Her second year there, the basketball team tied for first in its district.

Dr. Hughes spent only one year in the high school ranks. In the 1969-70 season, she coached the girls' tennis team at Sahuaro High School in Tucson, Ariz.

Dr. Hughes, assistant professor in Western's Department of Physical Education and Recreation, received her B. S. degree from Mississippi State College for Women, the M. A. Degree from University of Arizona and her Ph.D. from University of Utah.

### CAPTAINS

#### TERESA CONDIT AND EMILY PENNEY

The captains of this year's young basketball squad are sophomore Teresa Condit and junior Emily Penney. Both are guards for Coach Carol Hughes' team.

### DONNA DOELLMAN

Donna Doellman, one of several outstanding players signed by the Hilltoppers, is the first Cincinnati girl to sign a college athletic scholarship. In her senior year at Our Lady of Angels High School, the center averaged around 20 points a game. Doellman will play both forward and center for the Hilltoppers.



### DAPHNE EASTERLING

Daphne Easterling is a junior college transfer from Mississippi Gulf Junior College. She averaged 14 points a game her second year there. Easterling was an All-Stater at Long Beach High School in Long Beach, Miss.



### PAM KORDENBROCK

Pam Kordenbrock was one of the top high school players in the state of Kentucky last season. She was first team All-State at Dixie Heights High School. Kordenbrock averaged 31 points a game her senior year and was the leading senior scorer in the state.



### BETH LANE

Beth Lane is another "ace" high school basketball player recruited for Western. She was one of the top players in the state of Georgia. Lane averaged 18 points a game and earned All-Regional honors at West Rome High School in Rome, Ga. She was also an outstanding miler in track.
