The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *Herbert above the age of 21^{years}* and *Erwin Graham daughter of George Graham the Cousin of said Graham being duly certified & proven*

then this obligation to be void, else remain in full force and virtue.
