The following is another of Mr. R. T. Martin's many historical articles, copied from one of his scrapbooks. Unfortunately it, like the one in the previous issue of The Heritage, is undated and does not indicate where it was printed. However, it is, as usual, filled with much family data which should be of help to our readers.

THE FAMILY OF HUTSON MARTIN

Some time ago we gave a sketch of the family of William Martin, in which we mentioned his brother, Hutson Martin, also a son of Thomas Martin, of Virginia. Hutson Martin was born in Goochland county, Virginia, in the year 1781, and together with his mother, two brothers and two sisters came to Nelson county, Ky., during the latter part of the 1790's where he remained some years. In 1803 he stole from the home of Col. Lockridge, of Tennessee, his daughter, Anna, who was born in 1777, and he married her in Kentucky, and in 1805 he came to Muhlenberg county and settled about six and one-half miles west of Greenville near his brother, William Martin, where he became a progressive, well-to-do farmer and died in 1838. His wife died in 1869. To them were born and reared ten children, five sons and five daughters.

Andy, the oldest son, was born in 1804 and died in 1856. He married Fanny Rice, a daughter of Ezekiel Rice, who was a son of William Rice, a pioneer settler. To Andy Martin and Fanny Rice Martin were born and reared ten children, five boys and five daughters: Gus, Hutson, John, Jefferson and Joseph; girls: Ann Mary, Ellen, Salena, Susan and Vitula. This family moved to Missouri in 1855 and only two survive, Jefferson and Susan.

William W., the second son, was born in 1812 and died in 1887, and married Mary Ann Lovelace. To them were born and reared three sons, Columbus, James and Jackson; three girls: Laura, Belle and Susan. One of this family survives, Belle, now Mrs. T. M. Morgan, of Illinois.

John, the third son, was born in 1816 and never married. He went South and died in Mississippi in 1878.

James, the fourth son, was born in 1820, died 1885. He married Elizabeth Bell, a daughter of William Bell. She was born in 1830 and died in 1902. To them were born and reared one son, William, and two daughters, Ann and Belle. William is the only survivor of this family.

Felix, the fifth son, was born in 1824 and died in 1901; married Caroline Eaves, daughter of John S. Eaves. She was born in 1827 and now survives, and is the only living monument of the John S. Eaves family. To them were born and reared ten children, six sons: John, George, Rufus, William, Joseph and Charles; four daughters: Jennie, Anne, Bettie and Lilly. Two of the ten children are dead, Rufus and Lilly.

Jane, the eldest daughter of Hutson Martin, was born in 1806, and married Jackson Rice, a son of James Rice, and to them were born and reared six sons, James Baylas, Martin, Lewis, Felix and Charles; two daughters: Malissa Ann and Mary Ellen. Of this family there are four survivors, Martin, Lewis, Felix and Mary Ellen.

Mary, the second daughter, was born in 1808; she married George Ingram and to them were born and reared three sons, James, Charles and Felix; two daughters, Ellen and Betty. Two of this family survive, James and Felix.

Susan, the third daughter, was born in 1814 and died in 1854; she married James Rice, who was born in 1808 and died in 1862, a son of Ezekiel Rice. There were born and reared three sons: William, Ezekiel and Felix; five daughters: Luro, Laura, Mary, Cordie and Susan.

Ellen, the fourth daughter, was born in 1818, died 1857; married John Grigsby, and to them were born and reared three sons: William, Aaron and Moses; six daughters: Anne, Laura, Susan, Luro, Ophelia and Ellen. This family moved to Missouri, where all died but four girls, Susan, Luro, Ophelia and Ellen. They moved back to Kentucky in 1868 and now survive.

Laura Ann, the fifth daughter, was born in 1826 and now survives, the only living representative of the Hutson Martin family, in her 85th year. She married James Allison, born in 1825, died in 1870. To them were born and reared two children, one son, Frank, one daughter, Anna. Frank and his mother are the survivors of the family. After the death of Allison, she married A. M. Terry, born 1828, a son of Thomas Terry, who now survives.

Thus ends the sketch of a family commenced one hundred and thirty years ago in Virginia.

We continue the printing of the early 20th century birth records for Muhlenberg County, with sheet No. 24. All births on it are from 1909, and again, unfortunately, the sheet has no signature. It seems likely that the doctor would be the one who served the Duncan Coal Company employees, since most of the births are from Graham.
