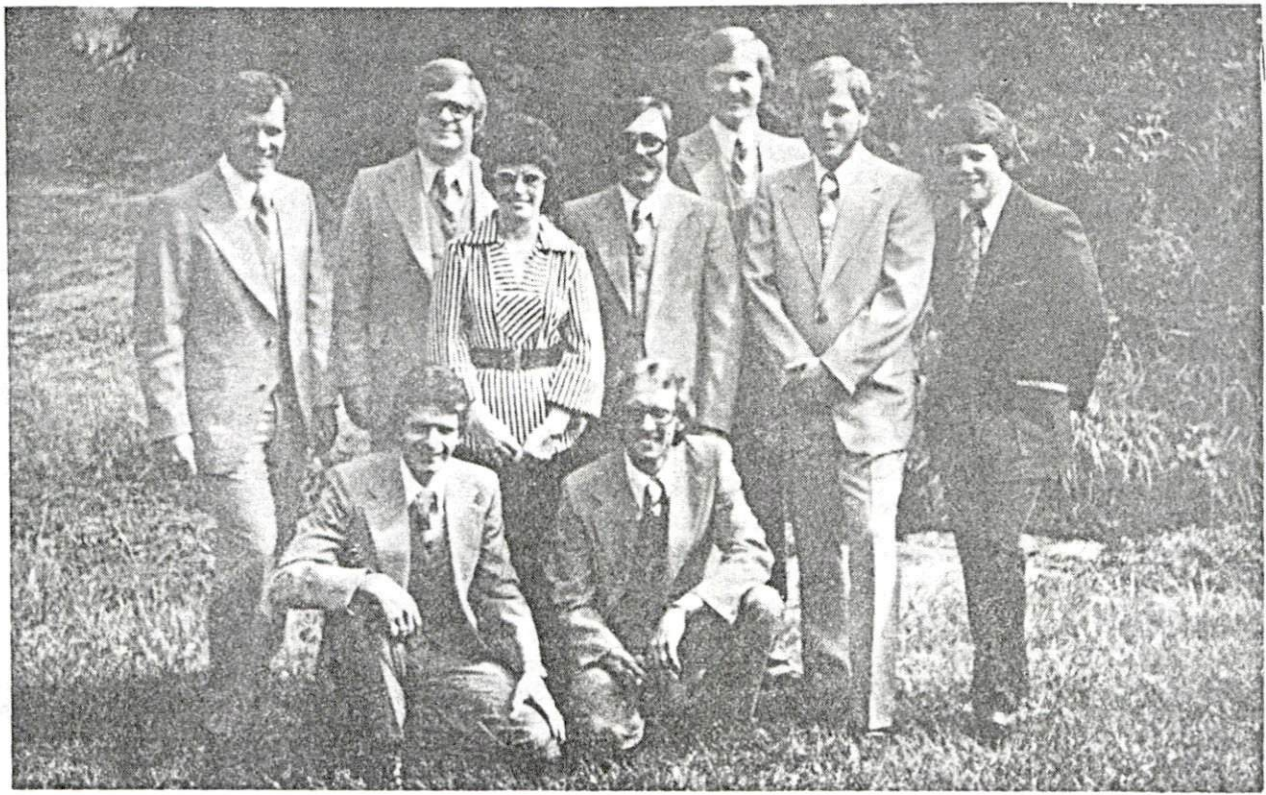

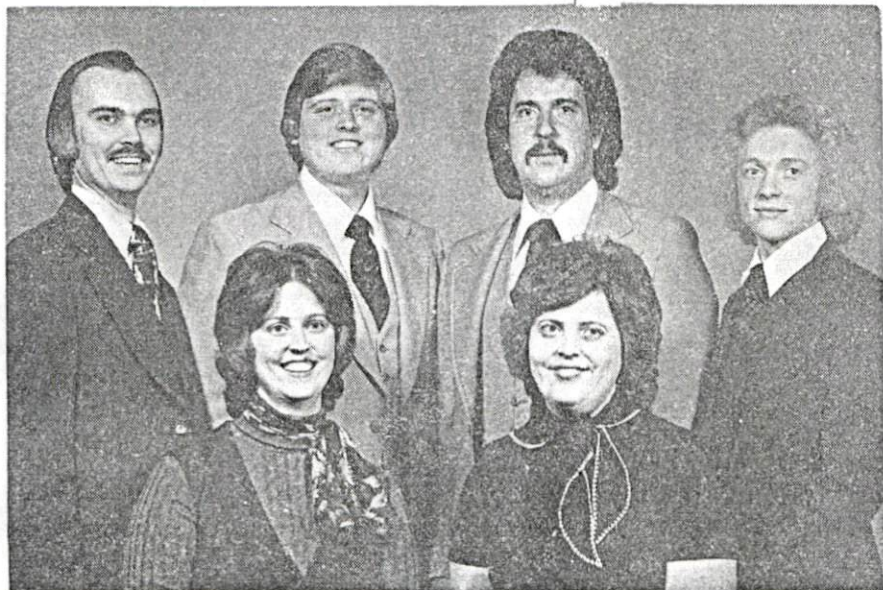

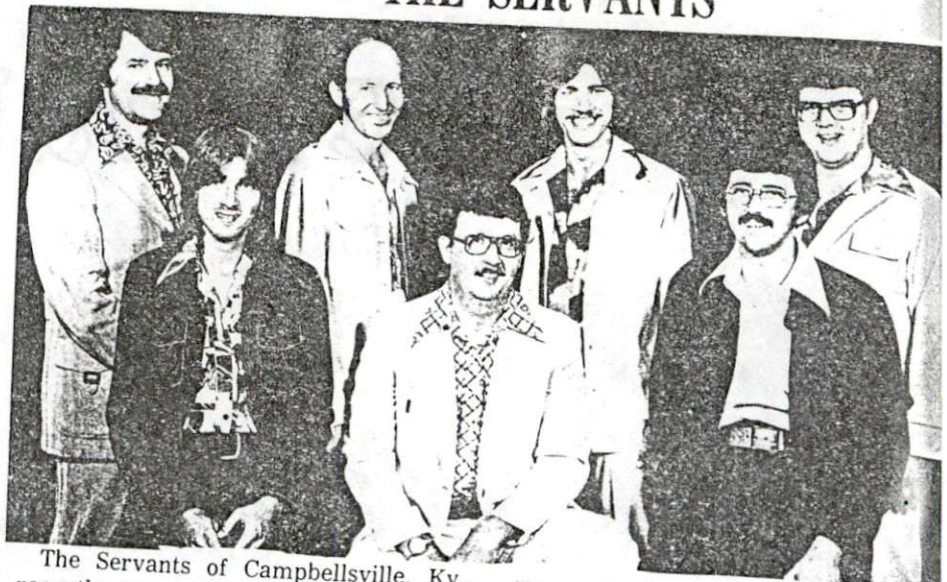

James Sego Praises Gospel Reaching Out



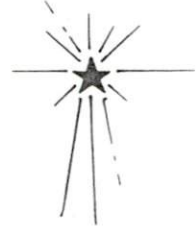
James Sego talks to Haskell McCubbins and Annette McCubbins about Gospel Reaching Out.
