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## SUMMARY OF THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF ACADEMIC DEANS

The Council of Academic Deans met Monday, April 29, 1968, in the office of Dr. Cravens. All of the deans were present.

The following is a summary of the deliberations of the meeting.

I. Some members of the Rules Committee of the Academic Council met with the deans to discuss the enlargement of the faculty representation on the Academic Council. It was agreed that Dr. Cravens would request that four elected faculty members would be added in 1968-69 and five in 1969-70. This would be an addition of one from each college plus one additional from the graduate school in 1969-70.

II. A committee is to be appointed to review and study with the deans the general education requirements of all curricula. The following members have tentatively been elected for the committee:

III. The details concerning the inter-session classes will be worked out by Dr. John Scarborough, Dr. Hourigan and Dr. Minton. Undergraduates should indicate to Dr. Hourigan the course they want to take and graduate students should indicate to Dr. Minton the course they want to take.
