

The Master's Disciples are staying busy these days. On April 2, they will be at the Eddyville Reformatory at 12:00 a.m., Eddyville, Ky.



She sang weekly at the Green River Gospel Caravan for one year. She has also sang for various church and religous gatherings in surrounding counties.


The past three years have been busy for her. She is in the second grade at Greensburg Elementary Scool in Green Co. She also attends Brush Creek Baptist Church.

We are all married and are members of the Macedonia General Baptist Church in Franklin, Ky. We enjoy GOSPEL REACHING OUT very much.


We have not been singing very long, but the Lord has surely blessed us and we pray as we continue to sing we will see many


