- Time of Meeting The Associated Student Government of Western Kentucky University held its regular meeting October 5, 1976. President Vogt called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.
- Committee Reports
- Activities Rick Kelley reported that Bob Woodward has cancelled his appearance for Wed. October 6. Robert Klein has cancelled his appearance for November 4. Approximately 5,000 tickets have been sold for the Chicago concert.
- Student Affairs John Evans reported that volunteers are needed for the discount committee.
- Rules & Elections Tom Hayes reported filing for homecoming candidate will begin October 11-20. The election will be in DUC and last for one day. Hayes also reported that approximately 380 students voted in the Freshmen election.
- Academic Council Tim Leigh reported the academic council met Sept. 30. A number of courses were approved - A proposal for the Academic charter was heard; however, it failed. John Korinek submitted a proposal for the suspension of school on November 1, 1976 to the Academic Deans on Tuesday, October 5.

Resolution #9 has been tabled indefinitely
