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PIONEER DAVID ENGLER

David Engler was somewhat of a mystery man. We have records to prove he really did exist, we have many family legends about him, and he left a host of descendants, but we cannot prove when he was born or when he died.

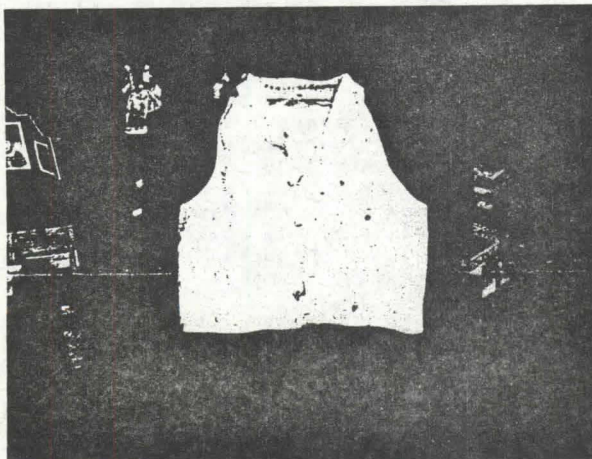
Engler is a German Name, designates a descendant of Engelhr (angel army); in some cases it refers to one who came from Engeln (angel), the name of three towns in Germany. The name is spelled, Englar/Engler/Englor/Inglar/Ingler. It is believed they originated in Switzerland. They came to America from England early in the 17th Century.

Family legend, passed on by John D. "Babe" Brown, (deceased) a descendant of David Engler, says they came from England with the Hunts and Harpers. Before reaching America, the parents became ill and died. The Hunts, who were somehow related, brought the two Engler sons on to America and raised them. Later when England sent the "Twenty girls" over to be wives of the colonists, one of the Engler boys and one of the Hunt boys chose a wife from these girls. He also states that the Engler brothers became separated somehow and were never re-united.

There is also a legend that Capt. Adam Englar brought two nephews to America from Switzerland. There are many records of this Capt. Adam Englar. One report in the Virginia Gazette, March 31, 1774, says, Capt Adam Englar perished with his ship on the Island of Madiera in a storm which destroyed the Island and 8 ships.

It is believed that our David Engler was born in New Jersey about 1750/55. Mr. Brown relates that David was a descendant of Joseph, son of Ephraim. Some other possibilities for his parents are from Passenger lists of ships from England. On 11 Sep 1728, Ullerig Engeler and Adam Engeler gave oath of Allegiance as they left the ship Goodwill from Rotterdam. Passengers on board the ship "Leslie", 7 Oct 1749, among others were Joan Jacob Engeler and Jost Engeler. And Arriving on board "Isabela" from Rotterdam 30 Apr 1806 was Matthe Engeler. When I was reading the Quaker Church records, I found Phillip and Ephraim mentioned more than once. However I was unsuccessful in linking either of them to David.

The one important fact we have not been able to prove is that David Engler was a Revolutionary War soldier. Our family legend again says that he was wounded in the leg at Valled Forge and remained a cripple the rest of his life. He whittled himself a walking cane from an apple tree, which was shattered by a cannon ball. That cane is somewhere now among his many descendants. Homer M. Hightower (a descendant) from Florida sent me a memographed copy of a picture of the vest David wore in the war. In 1984 it was shown to Eunice Blythe Hutchinson in Indiana. She was allowed to make a picture and drawing of it. She describes it as being made of natural color linen like material and was woven by hand at home. The back is plain and the front has a very fine dark line woven in. The buttons are covered with the same material. All the facings and seams were stitched and whipped by hand. The vest is waist length.



David Engler served in the "Jersey Blues". He joined up in Bordentown, Burlington County, New Jersey, but his residence was not given. In North Hampton Pa, just across the state line from Bordentown, a number of Englers joined the PA Militia. Adam, Leonard, Andrew, Gasper and Jacob. They each served more than one time. It was reported that Jacob was killed in action. Leonard, after serving several times was listed as a deserter. Were these David's brothers or cousins???

David Engler Cont'd

"It is hereby ordered that David Ingler be exempt from paying County levies in the future owing to his infirmity and wound received during the last war with Great Britain. In 1855 three of David's youngest children applied for a pension and it was denied for lack of proof of service.

KY Land Office Warrant #10364 issued 7 May 1825 gives David a 50 acre tract of land in Muhlenberg County on Mud River. KY Land Office Warrant #16336, dated 3 Aug 1827, he received another 125 acres in same neighborhood. Was this payment for his service in the Revolution??

David's three oldest children (at least) according to Census, were born in New Jersey. His first marriage, (wife's name unknown now) must have been in N.J. We found a Census record in 1790 in Frederick County MD for a David Ingler;

1 Male over 16 (that was David)

4 Males under 16

4 females (that includes wife and 3 daughters.

In Rowan County N.C., David Ingler again is listed 1800

1 male over 45

1 male 10 to 16

1 female over 45

2 females under 10

If both of these Census records are of Our David, then somewhere between MD and N.C. he lost 3 sons and 1 daughter.

David Engler, Sr.'s will is recorded in Muhlenberg County dated 15 May 1828. It was witnessed by John Wood, Owen Hunt and James M. Dallam. It was proven and ordered recorded in June Court the same year. It names "my six oldest children"; Polly, Liddy, Sally, David, Nancy and Milly. (one dollar and no more.) Then to his son John Joshua, (by his second marriage) and four youngest daughters; Peggy, Elizabeth, Tilly and Annie. I wonder why he failed to mention those three sons listed in 1790 Census. It must mean that that was not our David.

David's first wife may have been a Harper, or she may have been a Myrick. The Harpers and Englers lived side by side in N.C. and in KY. There seems to have been a close connection somehow. His second wife was named in his will as Joanna. She was a daughter of Pioneer John Hunt and his wife Charity. It is possible that Joanna was married before she married David.

I will now take David's KNOWN children and deal with them one at a time.

- L. Mary, (Polly) according to my calculations) was born in NJ about 1779. She would have been 19 or 20 when the family moved to N.C.. She may have married and remained in NJ. We know nothing of her.
2. Lydia, (Liddy), b. in NJ 1 Feb 1781, d. 11 May 1863 in Butler County. She m. David "Doss" Harper. His will in Butler County dated 1850 and proved June 1850. They had two sons; Lott and Squire. Lott m. 24 Apr 1823 Polly (Talbert) Elam, a widow. and Squire m. 9 Nov 1835 Eliza Jenkins .
3. Sarah (Sally), was born in NJ 1 Feb. 1781, d. 4 Feb. 1877. m. William Jenkins, 11 Mar 1800 in Rowan County N.C. Sally Ann is buried in Forsythe Methodist Church Cemetery near Oakland City, IN. She lived to be 92 years 7 months and 27 days old. Her children are listed (but not necessarily in order); Rebecca Jenkins, b July 1813 d. 26 Feb 1882 m. John Richardson, 27 Aug 1835 in Warrick Co. IN. Jeremiah Jenkins, m. Isabell Christmas. Nancy Jenkins, m. Harrison Christmas. Mansfield Jenkins m. Rachel Jordon. Enos Jenkins m. Amanda Maurer. James Jenkins, (probably was the youngest). Lemuel Jenkins, m. (1) Polly Jones, (2) Ann Keith, (3) Martha Wilhelm. (Ed Manley also lists, Minerva E., Jessie, Joel, and Eliza J. I have no further information on any of them))
4. David Engler, Jr., b. about 1786 in NJ. and d. in Muhlenberg County KY about 1847. His will was recorded in Butler County dated 7 July 1847 and witnessed by I.D. McCurdy and David Harper. It is believed that he was buried in the Old Hebron Cemetery in a rock fenced plot with two other men.
David Jr. was m. twice; (1) Lydia (or Polly) Harper, (2) Melinda Arndell 19 Apr 1840 in Butler Co.. His will names only his Melinda and youngest three sons. Melinda was pregnant when he died, for there is a fourth son credited to David. Melinda married again and moved to Warrick County IN before 1860 Census. I will list all of David Jr.'s children later.
5. Nancy Engler, b. about 1788 N.J., d. in Eureka, Kansas 2 Aug. 1878. She m. in Butler County 1 Jan. 1838 to Abraham Sumner. (b. 14 Jan. 1814 Butler Co. and d. Elma WA 30 Jan 1905) If these dates are right he was nearly 30 years younger than she. I got my information from Laura Hashbrook, (a granddaughter) Elma WA. Abner and Nancy had 14 children, 3 sets of twins.

Nell writes: In 1853 the William Robinson Family came to Gonzales, TX from Greenville, Muhlenberg County, KY. Permellia Jane died and is buried in Gonzales County. In 1855 or 56 the family moved to what is now Bee County TX. When William's horse came home without him, the family went to search and found him dead. He was buried there under a "lone oak tree" between Candlish and Berolair.

Death of Old Citizen: Robert M. Robinson- Old Veteran passes away on Christmas Eve. He was a veteran of the Ranger Services and of the Civil War. He helped organize Bee County and sat on the first Jury.--- He is referred to as a "land mark",. The article goes on to say: He came of sturdy yeomanry, which crossed the Cumberland with Boone in the last century and planted Anglo-Saxon civilization in KY.

Mr. H. Thomas Tudor states in his booklet "Early Settlers of Fort Boonesborough" pg. 17 that a William Robinson and a David Robinson were in Boonesborough in 1775-- the year Boonesborough was established.

From Anna Turley Roland's notebook an early settlers of Boonesborough-----

William Robinson married Peggy Garrold

Dau Margaret Robinson b. 13 Apr 1775 on Roanoke River in Fincastle-- afterward Botetort and now Montgomery Co VA, She m. 18 Aug 1773 (note: there is something wrong with those dates) Col Alexander Robertson in Bedford Co. VA. She d. 13 June 1846, age 92 at the residence of her son-in-law, Ex. Gov. Robert P. Letcher in Frankfort, KY. Margaret Robinson (sister of William) m. Robert Boggs of New Castle Co., Del. Robert Boggs is listed on p 3 of Mr. Tudor's Booklet as being in Boonesborough in 1775.

Maurice Bradford Ballard states that at the time Fort Boonesborough was built in 1775 there was a William and David Robinson and a Robert Boggs at the fort.

Anna Turley states that "if indeed our Robinsons crossed the Cumberland with Daniel Boone in 1775, it seems to me that William, a son of James was the Father of David, who in turn was the father of our David, who m. Rachel Dennis and Robert who m. Mary Dennis.

Daniel Boone in KY, by Rev. Thomas B. Gregory Apr 30, 1769. It was 143 yrs ago today, Apr 30 1769 that Daniel Boone got his first glimpse of the fair region now known as KY. On that day Boone with James Robinson, a young Scotch Irishman, stood on a mountain path and looked down upon the Watuaga winding thru its enchanting valley and he resolved that it should not be his last vision of earthly paradise. --- found in KY Historical Register Sep 1912 and a clipping sent from Philadelphia.

David Robertson, Jr. s/o David and Rachel Dennis Robertson was listed in Amadon Co. CA in 1860.
