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Mr. Gayle Carver asked that the following be included in the Heritage to preserve it for posterity. It appeared in the Greenville paper between 1910-1912. It was written by R.T. Martin under the pen name of Rondo. Some words are gone because of damaged paper, but what remains may be of help to someone. As always, the facts should be proven.

THE FAMILY OF ALBRITTON DRAKE

A FAMILY IN MUILENBERG COUNTY WHO ARE SLOWLY BECOMING EXTINCT

We here give a short sketch of the family of Albritton Drake, who was born in NC in 1755, and died about 1834. He was a son of James Drake, who claimed to be a descendant of Sir Francis Drake, who was born in 1545, dying in 1595. This Albritton Drake was a soldier in revolution of "76" and was married to Ruth Collins in NC, to which union was born seven sons and one daughter.

Albritton Drake with six sons and one daughter, came to TN, stopping for a short time, where his daughter married Willie Alford and remained in TN. Albritton Drake, with his six sons, Silas, Collins, Perry, Benjamin, William and Edmond came to KY and Muhlenberg CO in 1708 and settled on the waters of Pond river and Long creek in the southern part of the county, where three of his sons also settled, Silas, Collins and Edmond. Ben Drake drifted south to MS where he became a noted Methodist preacher. Perry Drake went to IN and became a lawyer of some distinction and was a soldier in the Mexican war. In 1861, the beginning of the Civil war, he went South and died. The second son Silas Drake was born in 1790 and died in 1858. He was a farmer and a Methodist preacher of the old school. He married Mary Wells, a daughter of Micaiah Wells, to which union was born seven children, Urban, Posey, Alber, Ben and A.W.C. Drake, daughters, Matilda and Martha, who married John and Ben Talbert, they moved to IL. The family of Silas Drake are all dead, some scattered grandchildren. Mrs. Mary Wells and Mrs. (sorry several words missing here) are grand-daughters of Silas Drake, son of Albritton Drake.

Collins Drake, was born in 1795 and died in 1885. He was a soldier in the War of 1812. He married Lurana Wells, a daughter of Micaiah Wells, and to this union were born six sons and five daughters, A.M., John P., Ed L., Marion, Mike, and Moseley, daughters, Ruth, Amanda, Priscilla, Sophia, and Jackie. A.M. Drake married Elizabeth Hancock, daughter of W.W. Hancock. J.P. never married, nor did Mike. Ed. L. married Sophia Drake, a daughter of Edmond Drake. Marion married Emily Saddler. Moseley married Amanda Saddler and Amanda Drake was the first wife of Moses Rice, and Ruth Drake, his second wife. Moses Rice was the son of Esequiel Rice who was the son of Wm. Rice, a soldier in the revolution of 1776, and came to KY in 1784, and to Muhl. CO in 1810. Priscilla Drake married John Wells, who died and she married John Jenkins, the father of Amos Jenkins. Some years afterwards he "died" and she went to CA and there died, leaving two daughters of Jenkins in that state. Jackie married Thos Saddler. Sophia married Jim P. Drake, son of Edmond Drake, three children of the family now survive.

The Drakes, Wells and Saddlers seem to have had a great attachment for each other. Collins Drake, prior to the war, was a slave owner and a well to do farmer, he has two sons and a daughter now living in the county, and several grandchildren, of whom are W.E. Drake and Mrs. H.H. Haviland now living in the town of Greenville.

Wm. Drake, the sixth son of Albritton Drake was born 1804, and died in 1868. He was married to Armina Rice, a daughter of James Rice, who came to Muhl. CO at early date. William Drake was a progressive and well to do farmer; he settled in the eastern part of the county on a tract of land where Drakesboro is now located his family consisting of James, John, Margaret, Sophia, Ruth and Sue. James, the oldest son, went South and died in Jacksonville, FL. Margaret married W.A. Thompson and is now dead. Sophia and Ruth both died in early womanhood. Sue married J.E. Langley, who lives on part of the old homestead. John Drake, the second son, whose picture appears in this article remained for some years on the old homestead and then leased his interest in the land to the Green River Coal and Mining Company, who are (Picture) doing a mining business and have built up a nice size town. Drakesboro. John Drake, after leasing his land moved to Bowling Green. Two of William Drakes' children are now living.

Edmond Drake, the seventh son of Albritton Drake, was born in 1806 and died in 1888. He also was a progressive farmer and settled on the waters of Long creek. He married Ann Wells, a daughter of Micaiah Wells and to that union were born six boys and three girls. The boys, Micaiah, Patrick, Jim P., Frank, Ebb and Doc; girls, Ann, Ruth and Mollie. The family of Edmond Drake have scattered and died, until there remains but one in this county, which is Patrick, living about five miles southwest of Greenville. P.H. Drake was born (sorry two lines missing). He married (that is missing too) --- a daughter of ----- Tolbert and Rosa Reynolds Roggess, to which union were born four children, three boys and one girl, Birdie, who died in early womanhood. Two of his sons live in Greenville and one lives with him on the farm.

The Drakes were generally of the Methodist religious faith and Democrats, except the family of Edmond, who were Whigs after the war came up. They all became Southern sympathizers and devoted life long democrats.

We have here given a scattered sketch of a family that will soon become extinct in the County. As time rolls on, people and things pass away; these old families once toiled and lived and were busily engaged in the industries of the county.

Rachel (Dennis) Robertson and James S. Smith

This intenture made this 15th day of November in the year 1825 between James S. Smith of the County of Muhlenberg and Commonwealth of KY of the one part and Rachel Robertson of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that whereas the said James S. Smith & Rachel Robertson are about to enter into a state of matrimony, and the said Rachel being the widow of David Robertson, deceased, and whereas she hath had set apart to her by commissioners her dower in and to the estate of said Robertson, now in order that no dissatisfaction may arise between the parties aforesaid. It is clearly understood and agreed between the parties that as to the estate or property aforesaid, that the said James S. Smith or his heirs are to set up no claim to any part thereof. But that the said Rachel shall have full and free disposal of the same to her heirs or in any manner she may think proper. In Testimony whereof the parties aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and seals, the day and year above written.
