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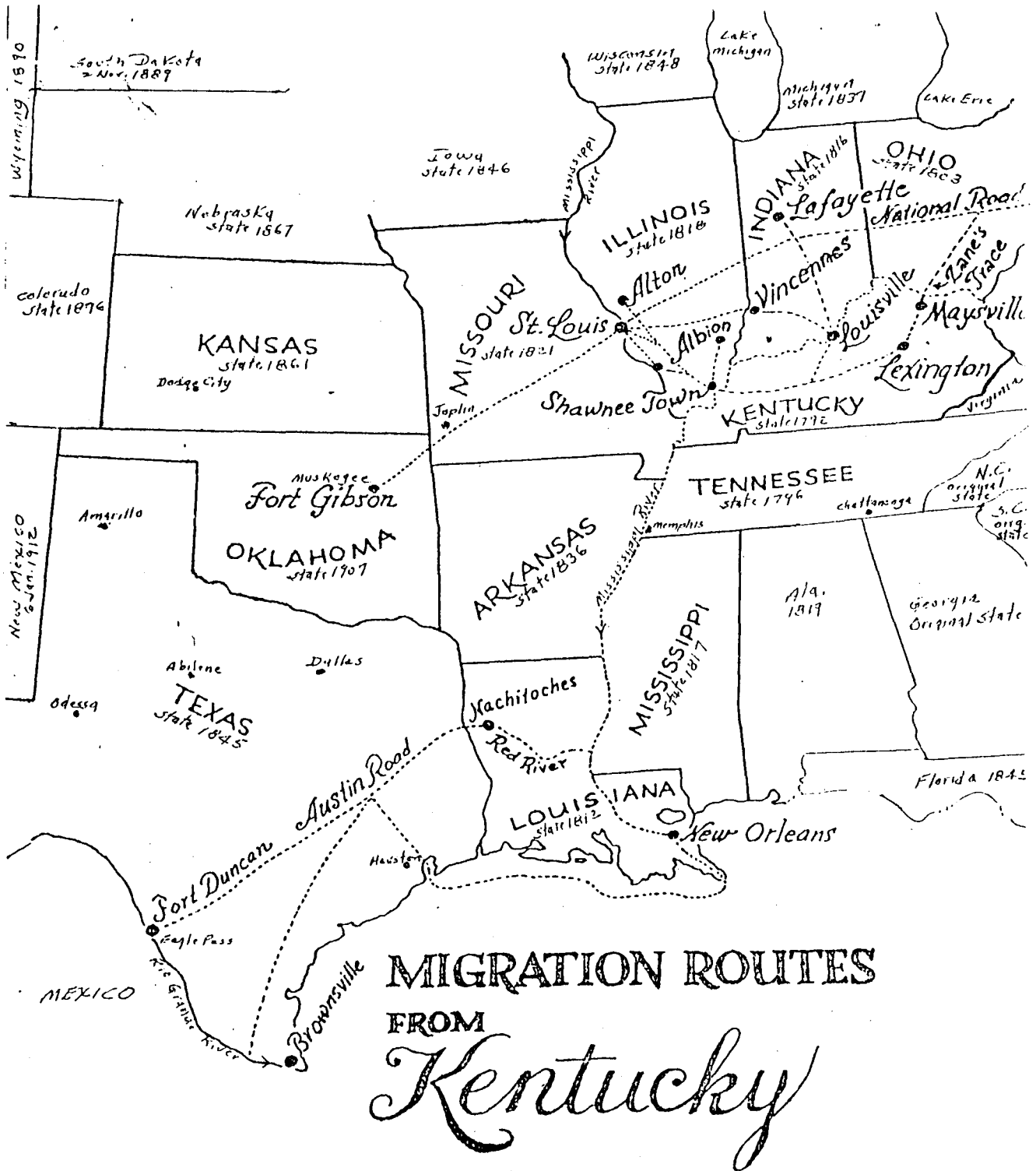

MICHAEL ROLL, REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIER
EARLY KENTUCKY PIONEER

Michael Roll, physically unable to appear in court, was on the 24th day of March 1834, duly sworn before Solomon Rhoads, a Justice of peace for the county of Muhlenberg, state of Kentucky. He states that he is seventy one years old and boidly infirmity prevents him from manual labor.

He entered the service of the United States in the year 1776, at the age of 14 years, under Captain Michael Troutman, Col. Johnston, in the state of Maryland. He was marched to a camp near Brunswick, NJ, where he spent two months, discharged in the very early spring. Again in the spring of 1777, in Cumberland CO PA, he joined up under Capt. James Byrons as a substitute for his father, John Roll, who had enlisted for six months. He served in the Packhouse service at Pittsburg. Then marched to Fredricktown, where he was discharged in September or October. In the year 1778, he again entered the service as substitute for a person whose name "I have forgotten", under Capt. Alexander for two months on the frontier between Potters fort and Redwine fort. Was discharged at the end of two months at Oldtown. He served as a scout against the Indians. The Indians were constantly attacking the counties of Cumberland and Huntingdon. In this engagement he served from June 1778 to October following in the service as a volunteer.

He had no documentary evidence, having lost all his discharge papers, and knowing no person who can verify his service.

Simeon Vought, a clergyman, and Thomas Howerton, residing in the County of Muhlenberg, state of KY, certify that they were well acquainted with Michael Roll, "we believe him to be seventy one years old, and that he is respected and beloved in the neighborhood where he resides." The neighbors believe he was a soldier in the Revolution and we concur with that opinion."

Michael states under oath, that he was born in state of PA in the year 1762. He was residing in Frederick CO MD when he enlisted in the service. His father then moved to Cumberland CO PA where they remained until the year 1797, when he moved to Hardin CO KY, where he resided until 1832, when he moved to Muhlenberg CO KY.

Another affidavitt signed by Elizabeth Vought, age 66, in 1834, residing in Muhlenberg CO, states that she knew Michael when he was stationed at the fort. Her father's family lived there and worked at packing provisions for the army. This Elizabeth probably was the widow of John Vought. She was born ca 1768, making her about six years younger than Michael. If Elizabeth was the widow of John, she was a daughter of Elder Francis Stump. However, there was another Elizabeth Vought on the list of families who came with Capt. Rhoads, with no explanation as to who she was. There was an Elizabeth Vought on the roll of the Mt. Carmel Baptist church near Paradise (charter member) 1839 until her death 19 Aug 1845. She probably was the mother of Simeon Vought.

I did not find a marriage for Michael Roll in Hardin CO KY, so will assume he married before coming to KY in 1797. There probably were other sons and daughters born before 1798, who settled elsewhere. Family tradition has it, that his wife was Christina Elizabeth Vought. She may have died in Hardin CO before he came to live in Muhl. CO.

I have six children documented for Michael Roll, Revolutionary soldier and farmer.

He has found a passenger list for the ship BIRGANTINE Mary and Sarah, date of 06 Oct 1754 from Amsterdam. One passenger HANNES (Johannes) ROLL, which he believes is John Roll sr. father of Michael Roll.

My will and desesire is that first my Executor sell the residue of my lands in Muhlenberg County except the coal bank property whereon I now reside to pay all my personal and private debts, if they should be sufficient therefor and if they are not sufficient then my desire is that they be paid out of the rents of my coal property -- my will is that all my liabilities as partner in the coal mining company be paid out of the rents arising from my coal property.

I give and bequeath to my tow sons Alney and Charles McLean a tract of land lying in Hancock County, State of Illinois containing 160 acres. My will and desire is that my two sons Alney and Charles take into custody my black woman Jenny and my two black men Sam and Elisha and take care of them and use them or hire them as may seem most advisable for the use and maintainance of my three daughters, Tabitha, Rowena and Transylvania -- I give to my two sons Alney and Charles and my three daughters all my personal effects consisting of household and kitchen furniture to be equally divided and distributed between them -- I give and bequeath to my daughter Rowenna my yellow boy Oscar to be valued to her as part of her interest in my estate -- after all my liabilities are fully paid and satisfied my will and desire is that there be paid to my son Robert D. McLean six hundred dollars -- thin I

The Honorable Judge Alney McLean, was born in NC 1779, came to Muhlenberg 1799 and began to practice law in Greenville in 1805. He was described as "a model gentleman of the old school, of great courtesy and kindness". In 1813 and 1815 he aided in repelling the invaders of his country in the battle of New Orleans, at the head of his company. He acted the part of a gallant officer. He served us in Congress and in 1821 he was commissioned Judge of the 14th District, where he served for more than 20 years, He died 31 Dec 1841. Mrs. McLean was the former Miss Tabitha Campbell, d/o Col. William and Tabitha R. Campbell.
