SUBJECT: FEBRUARY FACULTY SENATE MEETING

This is to notify you of the Faculty Senate meeting on Thursday, February 8, 1979, at 3:10 P.M., in the Garrett Conference Center Ballroom.

At this time, I am aware of the following items that will be on the agenda:

- I. President Minton will address the Senate.
- II. Several committees have wound up work for this semester and will have reports. I am specifically aware that: the Miller committee (Institutional Goals and Planning) has a major report, which will be in your folder, on enrollment trends; that the Parks committee (Faculty Status and Welfare) has new information concerning salary trends; that the Petersen committee (Professional Responsibilities and Concerns) has a report; that the Pulsinelli committee (By-Laws, Amendments and Elections) is working hard this week because of the up-coming elections and will need to report; that the Butler committee (Academic Affairs) will report on several issues of vital interest to those faculty members concerned with academic standards.

All committees, of course, will have the opportunity to report. I single the above out because I know they have major reports. You can conclude from this, therefore, that the meeting of February 8, 1979 will likely be long, and it will be important.

I urge your attendance more stridently than I ever have before.

One reason for this strong urging is that I anticipate press coverage, especially because of news media interest in faculty salaries and enrollment trends.
