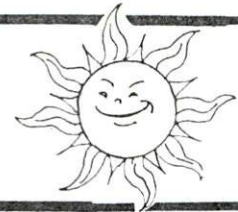

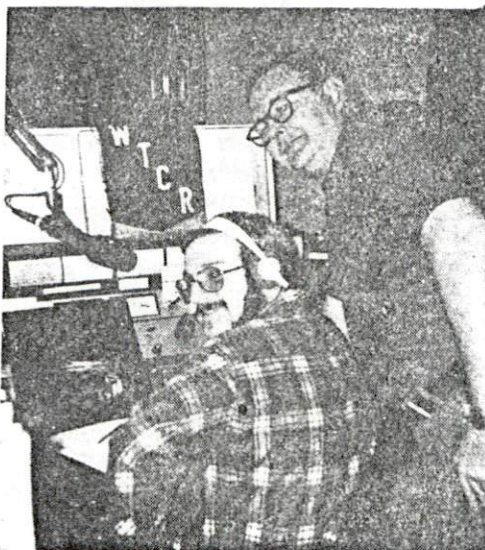

  - one-third c chopped pimento
  - 1/2 c slivered blanched almond (opt)
  - 5 tbsp flour
  - 1 large can evaporated milk
  - 3 c cooked rice
  - 1 3 oz. can broiled mushrooms sliced
  - one-third c chopped green peper (opt)
- Melt butter; add flour and blend. Add stock and milk and cook over low heat until thick, stirring constantly. Add salt. Alternate layers of rice, chicken and vegetables in greased 6" x 10" baking dish. Pour over the sauce (Top with almonds if preferred) Bake 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Serves 10 to 12 Note: It's elegant enough for company, easy on budget, can be frozen, and has answered my prayers on what can I serve to impress someone several times--and oh-so-good. I like to cook my rice in chicken stock after a 3 lb. fryer has stewed or simmered for 2 hours. After covering chicken with water, I add salt, onion, celery stalk, 1 red pod pepper and bay leaf to water to season. This stock make your rice taste better.
