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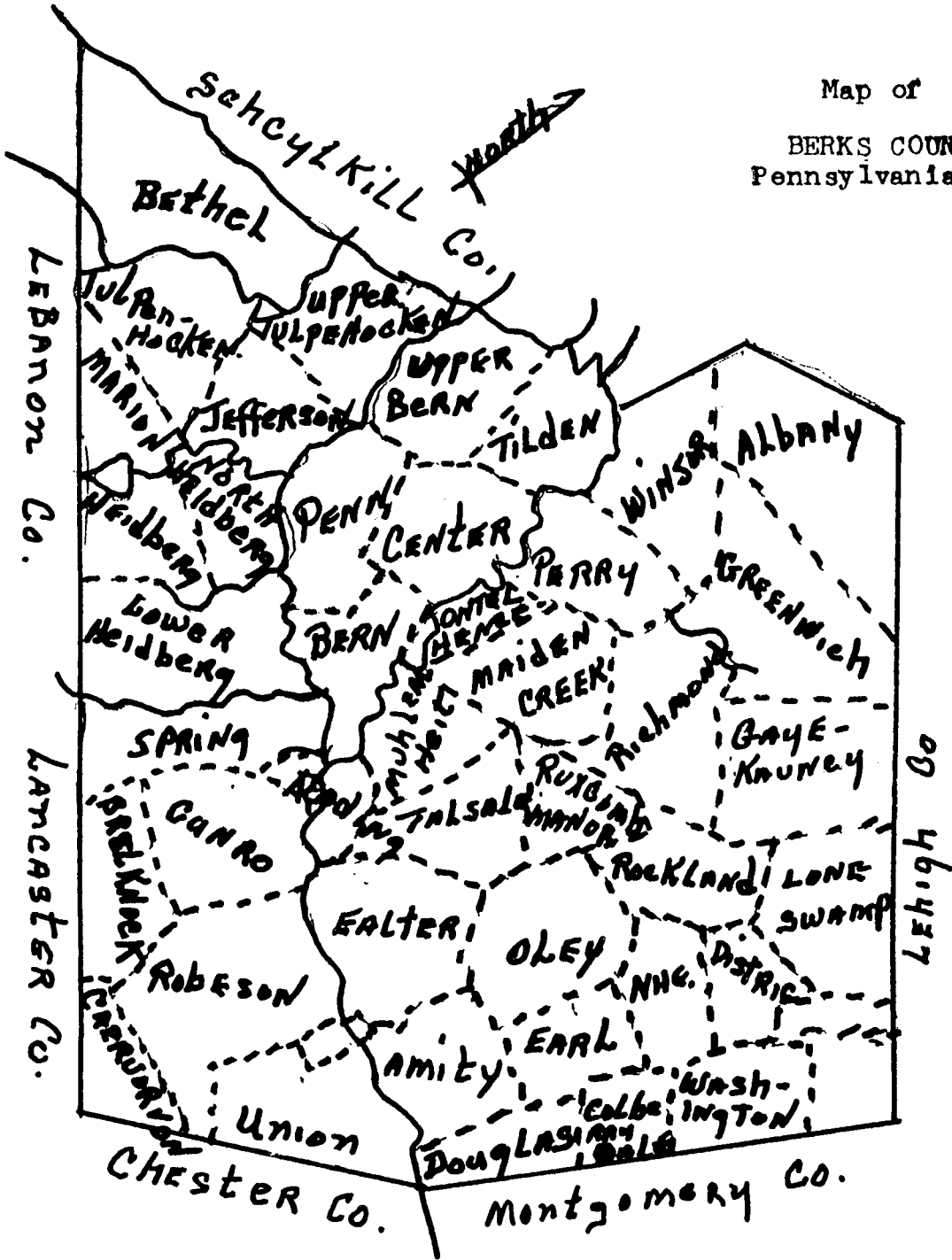

APLIN - EBELIN

In the September 1979 issue of the Heritage, we ran a copy of a Bible Record written in German, by Johann Ludwig Ebeling, b. 02 Mar 1758. This record was found in the back of the old Yonts Bible, which was left in the hands of Carlos Smith, and unfortunately it burned in a house fire several years ago. But thanks to Miss Joanna Fox of Drakesboro, KY a copy of the translation was preserved.

This translated copy gives his marriage to Miss Hard? Manni of Wayne CO NC, 07 Mar 1780. It lists births of five children, the first having been born ten years after this marriage date. "1790 on the 26th of March to me a daughter was born and was given the name Saara".

Recently, Mr. Lucian Barnes, 1204 Tate's Creek Pike, Lexington KY 40502, has sent me a large packet of copies of his research and I would like to share it with you. Along with some questions still unanswered.

In Berks CO PA Deeds Vol 29 p 300, 301, 302, 303, 1817 Aug 19 thru Nov 1817, A Will in probate lists the children of Ludwig Ebling of Rowan CO NC and appoints Francis and David Williams to represent them as heirs of their grandfather John Ebeling of Berks CO PA. George Hartman of Rowan CO NC attests that there are "8" living and "2" dec'd, children of Ludwig - "three mails and five feemails". Full release by the seven (apparently of age) heirs for receipt of their portion of the estate of John Ebeling, totaling \$807.84. Naming also the eighth child, Sarah Ebling. Signing were: Henry Ebling, Lazarus Ebling, William Michael, (who m. Mary Ebeling), Lazarus Ebling, George Ebling, William Younce, (who m. Caty Ebling), Laurence Younce, (who m. Elisabeth Ebling), George Hill, (who m. Rebecca Ebling) Henry and George Ebling, William and Laurence Younce, being from KY, and the rest of Rowan CO NC. Then on 22 Jan 1825 in Berks CO PA Misc. Bk B2:137, 138, Thomas Gault, of Lincoln CO TN, appoints William P. Orrick atty to demand of Jacob Hiesse etc, money due from estate of John Ebling in right of Sarah Gault, gr. daughter of John Ebling, she being one of the children of Ludwig Ebling of N.C. dec'd. This gives us the 8 living children of Johann Ludwig Ebling as of 1825. From this information I constructed the following Family group sheet for Ludwig Ebling:

This accounts for the "8" living and "2" dec'd children of Johann Ludwig Ebling as given in the John Ebeling Will. Using the Bible Record and calculating two years

apart.

The Ebeling's were from Holland and came to KY from PA: thus, known as "PA Dutch". You'll find them listed under several spellings such as: Abelen, Aplin, Appling, Eabling, Ebelin, Eberlen, Eberly, Ebling, Epling, and Eveling.

There are many by the above names arriving in America between 1709 and 1879. We believe the Johannes Ebeling, who arrived in Philadelphia 16 Oct 1752 aboard the Snow Kitty was the father of Johann Ludwig Ebelin, ancestor of a lot of us in Muhlenberg and surrounding Counties.

John was on the 1752 tax list of Berks CO, 1768 tax list of Alsace Twp. with 115 acres and on 1785 same twp. This property is described as being located just west of the present Reading Fair grounds. A large Rock Quarry now occupies most of it. There was a family burring ground on the farm, the remains are now at the Good Shepherd Cemetry at the Minnerschits Church. The Church records states "He lived to see 31 grandchildren". One Monument for Maria Barbara Ebling, b. 15 Aug 1697 d. 19 Mar 1785 in this Church yard may or may not be the mother of John Ebeling. If his parents ever came to America, it is not known. Also it is not known if there were other children besides John.

No name of composer on this chart, so I can't give credit due, but will include it here, for your consideration:

Daniel Meissey was CO-Executor with Maria Philippina for John's will. Wit:
 were Francois and Thomas Parvinley and Thomas Lightfoot. Maria Philippina was to
 "enjoy all of estate unless she re-married." 5 shillings to Ludwig's children and
 rest of his children share equal. Other children not named.

Maria Philippina's will written 07 Nov 1834, probated 13 May 1816 (written in
 German) Translation from Betty Widger's data, mentions her ailing son, Frederick,
 other children, but not named. She was living in Alsee Twp. Execs- were Paul and
 Valentine Ebling.

Henry was given as bondsman on the marriages for his sisters, Catherine and Elisa-
 beth in Rowan CO NC. He was on a list of Volunteers in Capt. Alney McLean's army
 from Muhlenberg CO, enlisted 20 Nov 1814 and took part in the Battle of New Or-
 leans 08 Jan 1815. His will recorded and probated in Christian CO KY and his child-
 ren getting married in Todd, Muhlenberg and Christian.

Henry Ebling, son of Ludwig Ebling, married Sarah Grissom, probably in N.C
 Though I could not find a record of it in Rowan CO. They lived in the Pond River
 Meeting House area northeast of Cary Bridge. Henry's will probated 03 Feb 1845;
 WBM: pg 25 and recorded in Christian CO KY. He listed his wife Sally, daughters;
 Sabry Stark, Elisa McElvain, and Susannah Ebling: sons: John T. (having left the
 State) and William Ebling.

Another Ebling in Muhlenberg CO in 1830 Census, though I don't know where he fits, was Lewis Ebling. No children and he and his wife were both in the 50-60 age group. In 1850 Muhl. CO Census, one Mary Aplin was living with the Rudolph Yonts family in Paradise. She was 78 and a widow. That poses the questions: who was she? Was she somehow related to Rudolph or his wife Sabry? Was she the widow of Lewis? . Many myatries still unsolved.

I have many family charts, all done by someone else, covering the many children of John and Maria. I will be happy to share them with anyone for the cost of postage and copying. AND if you can shed any light on any of these, we would be much appreciative.

Also I must give some credit to Dora Ann Lam, for much of this info.

HANCOCK and ALLIED FAMILIES

H. Benjamin Hancock, b. 25 Oct 1758, VA d. 5 Oct 1827 in Muhlenberg CO KY. m. 05 Apr 1790 Albermarle CO VA: (H/) Priscilla Franklin b. 10 Jan 1760 d. 20 Sep 1834 Muhl CO KY. Both buried in Hancock Cemetery, now overgrown. (R1,2 Vol 4 p69)

H1 Nancy S., b. 25 Apr 1792 VA, d. 09 Oct 1862. (R1) Rother's History states that Strother Jones m. Elizabeth Ann Hancock, and that he came to Muhl. CO in 1822, but Strother Jones was m. to Nancy Hancock in Bourbon CO KY 19 Dec 1818, the same year W.W. Hancock m. Delilah Baker there. The 1820 Muhl CO Census enumerates Benjamin Hancock, Strother Jones, and W.W. Hancock as side by side. Jones's first wife, b. in MD, gave him one son, Wm. G. b. Jun 1813 d. 06 Aug 1891. (He m. Rebecca S. Robertson, Muhl BK 11 Aug 1855, book does not give date solemnized, she died before 1870, no children). The 1850 Muhl Census gives Strother's wife as Ann S., but it should be Nan S. All other evidence confirms that she is this Nancy S. Hancock.

In a letter from Mary 11 Nov 1990 she states: I am also interested in the Todd CO Hancocks who may be related-- My grandmother Drake (Lissie Heltaley) had only one sister, Nannie, who m. a John T (or P) Hancock from Todd CO, son of W.A. Hancock. They had 3 children: Marie, who m. a Blackwell, a dau Eloise, and two sons. ((that doesn't add up right Mary- LCD))

In another letter Mary has another mystery: Rothert said that Strother Jones's 2nd wife was Elisabeth Ann Hancock. Since the Hancocks and Jones's were neighbors and came to Muhlenberg about the same time, I suspect that his 2nd wife was Elisabeth Jane Hancock. That however, does not track with other facts. I found a marriage in Bourbon CO (where the Hancocks were in 1818) of Strother Jones to Nancy Hancock 29 Dec 1818. This is probably Nancy (R1) and she is probably his 2nd wife as Rothert lists his only son by his 1st wife as b. 04 Jun 1813 d. 06 Aug 1891. His 3 sons by his 2nd wife were adults by 1849. Two of them were gold rush "49ers" and one later served as a Confederate Soldier. One was County clerk in Muhl during the Civil War, and would have been b. in 1820's, or early 30's most likely. Rothert must have had the first name wrong. I would like some help on this.

In 1840, Strother Jones is next door to James Birke Hancock-Nancy's brother. 1 m 5-10, 1 m 10-20, 1 m 20-30, 1 m 30-40 and 1 m 60-70. 1 f 50-60. Nancy was b. 1791 (age 49 or 50) at time of Census, so probably is Nancy rather than Elisabeth. I would like some other documentation.

The 1860 Census shows William G. Jones, Strother's son by 1st wife, age 47, wife Rebecca, 35 with no children.

The Jones-Hancock-Drake link is close knit, but I need something else to confirm that Nancy was Strother's 2nd wife. Any help will be greatly appreciated.

In a SPECIAL EDITION of ARM, ancestor Retrieval Messenger, by Bobby Anderson (Published quarterly for \$7.00 a year), 7965 Ridgewood Road Goodlettsville, TN 37072. (Bobby is a Muhlenberg County Boy) He poses the question; Did they find Joel's Wife's Grave????

The answer is "we think so!" and "we hope so!". The question refers to the wife of Joel Jenkins, Sarah (Sallie) Wood Jenkins, who mothered the first 14 of Joel's 24 children.

On a farm in the edge of Butler CO (next to Muhl. CO) near Arnold's Bridge (Highway 949). "Sallie Jenkins, b. 20 Jul 1795 d. 13 Nov 1839" This was the only engraved stone found in the undergrowth.

A check of records reveal that Joel Jenkins, the son of Jesse and Martha (House) Jenkins came to Butler CO from North Carolina shortly after 1800. These were the first Jenkins to settle in South Muhlenberg and North Logan CO. Joel was b. 24 Jul 1774 in NC (probably Rowan CO) and m. Sarah Wood in Muhlenberg 17 Dec 1811. (Note: some genealogists still contend Joel Jenkins m. Polly Neill in Logan Co the same year.

Joel and Sarah had 14 children (13 of whom can be named) before her death. Joel remarried again in 1840, when he was 66 years old, he and a 13 yr old Martha (Patsy) Wooley on 29 Oct 1840. On two horses, they rode to Springfield TN and were married. This marriage produced 10 children, all of whom are documented.

Joel Jenkins^{d.} 13 Feb 1863, almost 89 yrs old. He is buried in the Green Hill cemetery, on his old farm, just across the road and up the hill from his residence and that of Crawford Hunt.

The fact that he re-married in 1840, about a year following the death of Sallie, whose grave was recently found, is one bit of evidence that this is his first wife. The second, and perhaps a stronger bit of evidence is that the tombstone at Sallie's grave is exactly the same as the one marking Joel's grave, with the exception of their names and dates.

A descendant of Richmond V. Jenkins, s/o Joel and Sallie, tells the story, told by her grandmother, that Sallie was buried in the backyard of their home. So this could be, would be, and probably is the same Sallie Jenkins, wife of Joel. Write Bobby for more information..
