TEXAS MILLIONAIRE PIE

2 cups powdered sugar
1/2 cup softened butter
1 egg
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon vanilla

1 cup whipping cream
1/2 cup chopped nuts
1 cup crushed pineapple
(drained)
2 baked pie crusts

In mixer bowl cream together sugar and margarine. Add egg, salt and vanilla. Beat this mixture until light and fluffy. Spoon this mixture into baked pie crusts and chill. Whip cream until stiff; fold in nuts and pineapple. Pour this over the sugar mixture and chill thoroughly. This will make 2 - 8 inch pies or one very large thick pie.

(NOTE: A small bowl of Pet Whip or Cool Whip may be substituted for the cup of whipping cream, and Graham Cracker Crumb crusts may be used.)
