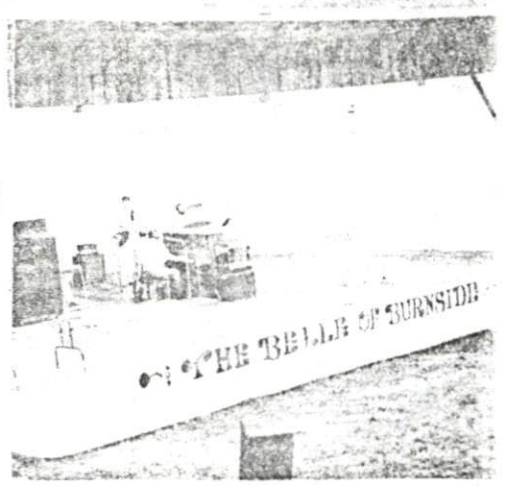

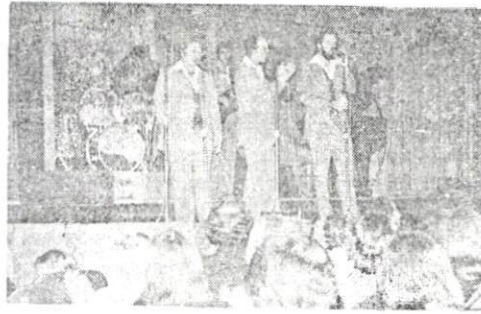
Lincolnaires 6th Anniversary Sing
