GMA News Release

NASHVILLE: At the invitation of the state of Israel, the Gospel Music Association will be sponsoring the International Festival of Gospel Music in that country tentatively slated for the first week in December of 1980. At the present time two free concerts are being planned, one in Jerusalem at the Binyanei Ha-ooma national auditorium and another in either the Galilee area or Haifa.

GMA board member Polly Grimes of Gospel Concerts in Los Angeles and Israeli consul Moshe Shoshani will be working





together to coordinate the event. Grimes is also setting up a committee of fellow GMA board members to assist. According to Grimes about five internationally know acts will be going, but as yet those acts have not been confirmed.

Grimes, who has presented a number of gospel shows in Israel during the past six years, just recently returned from there where she met with people from the Israeli government and impresarios from the music and television industries to lay out initial plans for the '80 festival. Both Israeli TV and film crews for the U.S. will be taping the event for release. Plans are also being worked out to record a live album.

Consul Shoshani will be visiting the United States in September of this year to finalize festival plans. Grimes hoped that everything will be finalized by this December, leaving a full year to set up details.

GMA executive director Don Butler states that the association is anticipating the U.S. State Department's recognition of the festival as a gesture of good will. "Music is a common denominator," says Grimes, "and I don't know of any better way to show good will and love and to project the Christianity we feel than presenting music to other countries."

"It's exciting because the people in Israel really love gospel music. Since Israel is a Jewish nation, the fact that they would open their arms to gospel music the way they are doing is just overwhelming. We have not scratched the surface of gospel music's potential."





Holiday Inn Clayton Plaza just prior to the Christian Booksellers Association (CBA) convention. The location switch and the addition of the word 'national' to the seminar's title were designed by the steering committee to broaden the event's appeal encouraging attendance from a wider range of gospel radio personnel representing various gospel music styles and interests.

A near 100 percent attendance at each session marked the newly sparked interest and excitement on behalf of seminar participants. According to Jim Black, seminar steering committee chairman. one of the significant factors in the success of this year's gathering was the increase in attendance from those in various areas of station management, which Black stated added more credibility to the panel discussions. The planning of the agenda itself separated this seminar from past efforts as 15 broadcasters from around the country set up the topics for discussion, an early involvement from radio that had not taken place before.

Plans are already being made for next year's seminar scheduled to be held in Dallas, again prior to the CBA convention.
