Opryland to feature Gospel Music

On March 29, Opryland U.S.A. will usher in the 1980s and a new decade of entertainment with special emphasis on what has made it unique in the theme park industry: The elaborate showcasing of some of America's most talented young people in productions that even turn the heads of Broadway producers.

The park will maintain its tradition of weekend operation in spring and autumn and seven-day-a-week operation in summer. The 1980 season, the park's ninth and also its longest, runs through Nov. 2. (Editors: Capsuled information about the season is at the end of this release.)

Favorite Opryland shows, such as "I Hear America Singing" and "Country Music U.S.A.," have been updated and fine-tuned, and they are being complemented by two new entertainment groups. The additions are a group known as the Opryland Cumberland Quartet that will perform a show called "Sing the Glory Down" at the Dixieland Patio in the park's New Orleans area and a nine-piece marching band that will entertain guests at the park entrance and various locations around the 110-acre park.

Gospel music, which always has been part of the "Showboat" production, is getting special attention. Besides "Sing the Glory Down," gospel music will be the focus of two special events--the Opryland Gospel Jublilee on May 24-25 and Freedom Festival '80 on July 4.

The two-day Gospel Jubilee will be in the Theater by the Lake and will feature artists such as the Hinsons, the Hemphills, the Inspirations and the Sego Brothers and Naomi. Freedom Festival '80 will be a series of gospel concerts in the Grand Ole Opry House to mark Independence Day.

An addition to the park itself for 1980 will be a group of craftsmen in the Hill Country area. In areas where you can observe the artisans at work, they will produce their handicrafts and offer the finished products for sale. Crafts that will be featured include woodcarving and wooden sign making, glass engraving and pottery.

Opryland has earned a reputation for its diversity of restaurants, ad a behind-thescenes addition should enhance that reputation this season. That addition is an on-site bakery that will provide breads, desserts and other baked goods for Opryland's numerous restaurants.

Examples of the bakery's production include cinnamon rolls and danish pastries that will be served with breakfast in the Plaza Cafeteria, French bread for specialty sandwiches in the Cafe Mardi Gras, fruit cobblers to complement the barbecue

in the Country Kitchen and dinner rolls for use in the Gaslight Beef Room.

The 1980 schedule: Open Saturdays and Sundays from March 29-May 25; open seven days a week from May 26-Sept. 1; open Saturdays and Sundays from Sept. 6-Nov. 2. Main gate opens at 10 a.m. Closing time varies according to the season.




