

Then in 1969 his name as "The Preacherboy" began to be heard by American people night after night as he was introduced from the stage by Martin Cook as a member of the Inspirations.

For over ten years, Eddie sang baritone for the Inspirations. During that tenure he recorded over fifteen long play albums, appeared with the Inspiratons as a regular member of the nationally syndicated "Gospel Singing Jubilee" for over five years, appeared on the Roger Mudd CBS prime time news cast in 1970, appeared in approximately two hundred cities per year with the Inspirations, accepted with the Inspirations the award for the favorite gospel group six different times, was voted the favorite baritone of America three times with the most recent vote coming in 1979. Eddie was also honored in 1974 with the honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from the Calvary Bible College in Jonesboro, Georgia. In 1977 he was voted by the Jaycees of America as one of the outstanding Young Men of America for that year.
