COUNCIL OF ACADEMIC DEANS

October 6, 1969

The Council of Academic Deans met in Vice President Cravens office on October sixth, at 1:30 p. m. All the members were present.

The following items were discussed by the Council:

- I. Dr. Cravens briefly reviewed the structure of the nature of the Bowling Green College of Commerce and suggested that Mr. Cook might meet with department heads in each college to explain its organization.
- II. Dr. Minton discussed the problem in regard to the relationship of KEA and Higher Education and invited the members of the Council to a 6:00 p. m. dinner on October 22 to discuss the issues.
- III. The Spring 1970 schedule is to be submitted to Mr. Cook, Wednesday, October 29.
- IV. Dr. Cravens announced that Ervine R. Levine will be sponsored by the Colleges of Liberal Arts and Commerce. Whitney Young will lecture on December 9 and be sponsored by Dr. Minton's college. The chairman announced that Levine, Hess and Young will compose the University Lecture Series and the other lectures will come under the Sperry - Hutchison Series.
- V. Dr. Cravens indicated that he would be glad to accept any nominees for the American Council on Education Internship.
- VI. Mr. Robert Cochran and Mr. Don Armstrong were invited to discuss the operation of their office and their relationship to academic affairs with regard to publicity and communication.
- VII. Agenda items 2, 3, 4, 6 were continued.
