

## Billy Kennedy, Scots-Irish Expert to Speak in Bowling Green

The Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society, the Landmark Association, and the Kentucky Library at WKU are pleased to present a lecture by Northern Ireland journalist and author, Billy Kennedy. He will discuss the Scots-Irish diaspora in the United States, with particular reference to the late 18th century Kentucky and Middle Tennessee settlements including some of the luminaries who emerged from this hardy strain of people. The meeting will be held on Sunday, March 10th, at 2:30 p.m. at the Kentucky Library, Western Kentucky University.

Kennedy is a widely recognized journalist in Northern Ireland, where he has written for the past 30 years. With the Ulster/Belfast News Letter, a newspaper founded in 1737, he was a news editor for 18 years and assistant editor and lead writer for five. He now operates as a full-time freelance journalist, public relations consultant, author and lecturer. His abiding interest is in the history of the Scots-Irish settlements on the American frontier. Kennedy has lectured on the Scot-Irish diaspora in American in major cities and towns in the southeastern Appalachian region on the asstern seaboard and in Taxas. He is also



region, on the eastern seaboard and in Texas. He is also an authority on American country music and culture. Kennedy's six books are: The Scots-Irish in the Hills of Tennessee (1995), The Scots-Irish in the Shenandoah Valley (1996), The Scots-Irish in the Carolinas (1997), The Scots-Irish in Pennsylvania and Kentucky (1998), Faith and Freedom: The Scots-Irish in America (1999), Heroes of the Scots-Irish in America (2000). Kennedy's newest book is entitled: The Making of America: How the Scots-Irish Shaped a Nation. Kennedy will have some of the books available for signing at the meeting. This highly popular series of books considerably widens the inspiring story of how a highly determined and very courageous God-fearing people from the north of Ireland stamped their distinctive Presbyterian character on the various facets of American life.

In the establishment of the United States, the Scots-Irish were one of the most highly influential groups, both in the drawing up and signing of the American Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, and in the Revolutionary War which followed. This group of dedicated stalwarts, whose families emigrated to American from the Irish Province of Ulster throughout the 18th century, were resolute and uncompromising champions of the movement for American independence.

Our own inimitable Ed Moody will give a brief bagpipe concert after the presentation.

## Getting Ready for the 1930 Census

The 1930 census and all existing soundex indexes will become available on April 1, 2002 at the National Archives Building, 700 Pennsylvania Ave., N.W., Washington, DC 20408-0001, and at NARA's Regional Facilities in 13 major cities. The 1930 and later censuses are not available for public use because of a statutory 72-year restriction on access for privacy reasons. (92 Stat. 915; Public Law 95-416; October 5, 1978). The census day was April 1, 1930.

### **Microfilmed Soundex Indexes**

Indexes using the soundex indexing system exist for the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky (part), Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia (part).

These seven Kentucky counties are indexed: Bell, Floyd, Harlan, Kenton, Muhlenberg, Perry, and Pike. [Kentucky (M2053), 24 rolls] These West Virginia counties are indexed: Fayette, Harrison, Kanawha, Logan, McDowell, Mercer, and Raleigh. All of Tennessee's counties are included in the soundex. [Tennessee (M2058), 169 rolls]

#### **Geographic Descriptions of Census Enumeration Districts**

Geographic descriptions of census enumeration districts are reproduced in NARA microfilm publication T1224, Descriptions of Census Enumeration Districts, 1830-1950 (156 rolls). Descriptions of enumeration districts for the 1930 census are arranged by state, then by county, on rolls 61 through 90, as shown in the table below.

The 1930 census will be issued as NARA microfilm publication T626, Fifteenth Census of the United States, 1930. This table lists the number of rolls of census schedule microfilm for each state and territory.

## Questions on the Census

The 1930 census asked 32 questions about each person:

- 1. Street, avenue, road, etc.
- 2. House number (in cities or towns)
- 3. Number of dwelling house in order of visitation [supplied by census taker].

- Number of family in order of visitation [supplied by census taker].
- 5. Name of each person whose place of abode on April 1, 1930, was in this family.
- 6. Relationship of this person to the head of the family.
- 7. Home owned or rented.
- 8. Value of home, if owned, or monthly rental, if rented.
- 9. Radio set.
- 10. Does this family live on a farm?
- 11. Sex.
- 12. Color or race [White (W), Negro (Neg), Mexican (Mex), Indian (In), Chinese (Ch), Japanese (Jp), Filipino (Fil), Hindu (Hin), Korean (Kor), other races spelled out in full.]
- 13. Age at last birthday.
- 14. Marital condition. [Single (S), married (M), widowed (Wd), divorced (D).]
- 15. Age at first marriage.
- 16. Attended school or college any time since Sept. 1, 1929.
- 17. Whether able to read and write.
- 18. Place of birth--PERSON.
- 19. Place of birth--FATHER.
- 20. Place of birth--MOTHER.
- 21. Language spoken in home before coming to the United States.

Here follows 3 columns of "CODE (For office use only. Do not write in these columns)" relating to "State or M.T. [mother tongue]," "Country," and "Nativity." These codes were entered to assist in statistical tabulation and do not provide any information beyond that found in columns 18-21.

- 22. Year of immigration to the United States.
- 23. Naturalization.
- 24. Whether able to speak English.
- 25. Trade, profession, or particular kind of work done, as spinner, salesman, riveter, teacher, etc.
- 26. Industry or business, as cotton mill, dry-goods store, shipyard, public school, etc.
- 27. Class of worker.
- 28. Whether actually at work yesterday (or the last regular working day)--Yes or No
- 29. If not, line number on Unemployment Schedule. [Note: Unemployment schedules no longer exist.]
- 30. Whether a veteran of U.S. military or naval force--Yes or No.
- What war or expedition?
  [World War (WW), Spanish-American War (Sp), Civil War (Civ), Philippine Insurrection (Phil), Boxer Rebellion (Box), Mexican Expedition (Mex)].
- Number of farm schedule. [Farm schedules no longer exist].

The Land Grants South of Green River are contained in 29 books and comprise 15,730 separate grants. They were granted between 1797 and 1866. The grants, sometimes called "Headright Claims" were based on an Act of Kentucky General Assembly dated 21 Dec 1797. Until 1797, no person could enter a survey within this area except a soldier. The 1797 Act of the General Assembly opened up the vacant lands in this area to any person possessed of family and over 21 years old. Such persons were entitled to not less than 100 acres and not more than 200 acres. They had to have lived on the land for one year before they came into actual possession. They surveys upon which theses grants are based are recorded in 18 books in the Kentucky Land Office. The following are part of those recorded in Volume 1 of these grants. They were transcribed from the filmed original Grants South of Green River, Volume 1, 1797-1803, FHL film 0272828.

## Wood Family Bible

The Bible is believed by the owner to have been the family Bible of **Thomas B. Wood**. **Thomas B. Wood** was the son of **Joseph Wood** and **Elizabeth Keith**. According to Logan County, Kentucky Marriage Records, Joseph and Elizabeth took out a marriage bond in Logan County on 31 May 1798. Joseph and his probable brothers: **James**, **Avary**, **John**, **Thomas**, **Bartholomew**, and **Moses** had come to Logan County, Kentucky about 1799 and settled in the Muddy River area. By 1815, **Joseph Wood** had moved to Muhlenberg County and settled in the Hooper's Lick area. Some of the families listed in the Bible stayed in Muhlenberg County and others left the state for Missouri and other places.

The Bible is presently [2001] in the possession of Stephen Wood, 2014 Clinton Place West, Owensboro, KY. Stephen Wood inherited the Bible from his grandfather, Thomas Ewing Wood. Writing on several loose papers written by Thomas B. Wood is similar to the writing in the Bible. The Bible was photographed at the home of Stephen Wood on 21 September 2001 by Richard L. Miller and Gail Jackson Miller, CG<sup>SM</sup>. The photographs of the Bible are presently in the possession of Gail Jackson Miller, 425 Midcrest Drive, Bowling Green, KY. Transcribed by Gail Jackson Miller from the photographs. The Bible was missing the title page, but the concordance page following page 1080 of the Bible was intact.

Mr. **Mit. Hines** bade farewell to home and friends on Thursday of last week and started to Texas via the West. He was taken sick at Oakland, and remained over until the first of this week. May health, happiness and prosperity attend him in all his travels.

Miss Nancy Schroader will teach the spring session at Oak Grove Seminary.

Mr. E.F. Richardson has been teaching a writing school at the Grider school house, and will begin one at Oak Grove, February 11. He teaches twelve lessons for \$1 per scholar.

Mr. R.D. Stone will engage in the tobacco trade this season.

Mr. John Graham has established himself in the shop at Mr. Roup's mill, and is making the anvil ring.

For several weeks eggs have been selling at a handsome profit, but the funny part about it is no one scarcely has any to sell. There's the rub.

If the "Little Corporal" McElroy of your city, and Mr. D.C. Amos of Oakland, will consent to make the race for the Legislature, they will receive a hearty support from this vicinity. They are both too well known to need any compliments. Suffice it to say, should they be elected, Warren County would carry the banner in the next General Assembly.

Regular appointments for preaching at Mizpah every fourth Sunday.

Mr. C.N. Graham has been rusticating with relatives in Metcalf county for several days.

'Tis natural for some people to blab where they are not individually concerned and I am not altogether exempt. I am decidedly in favor of graded schools in your city,. Public school houses should be built, or your people should keep quiet about their "enterprise." If some responsible person would bind himself to furnish free drinks for the city, in consideration of a house and lot, I venture to say it would be furnished without delay. (Hit 'em again—EDS)

Messrs. John Quisenberry, Lod Jenkins, George Gray and James Rawley have each a fine, bran [sic] new boy; and Mr. Wat Ramsey a girl. What a smiling neighborhood and a yelling one, too.

I learn that Mr. **Perry Breedlove** contemplates moving to the vicinity of Louisville, where he is now engaged in work.

A proposition is on foot to build a turnpike from Mr. **Roup**'s mill to the Louisville and Nashville pike, provided the necessary funds can be raised. It would be a great benefit to the traveling public.

When a man gets mad, he is insane. So say **Tom Buford**'s judges. Well, if Tom should use his shot gun on a few more it might be beneficial, inasmuch as it would have a tend Our section of country is decreasing instead of increasing, in population. We have lost, in the last few years, a great many of our best citizens by death and removal. There seems to be a general exodus among all classes to the western country. The poor are hunting cheap houses, and the rich, cheaper lands, to invest their means in. Land is held too high here for the country to prosper.

W.H. Hudson, Willie Martin and Leander Tate have been making a geological survey of Edmonson county, prospecting for coal to run the Oakland mills. They succeeded in finding it, but the question then arose as to whether they would move the mill to the coal or the coal to the mill.

Mr. J.L. M. Strange is preparing to start to Kansas, where he expects to live until next fall.

Our mill has been on a strike so long that the children about Oakland call crackers cold biscuits.
