

## Lister Says, "Statemen Are Here to Stay"

Hovie Lister, manager of The Statesmen, recently released a statement that he is keeping The Statesmen intact "until the Lord comes." This declaration was prompted by rumors circulating to the contrary after Lister and tenor Rosie Rozell's infrequent appearances with The Masters.

Lister emphasized that The Masters is "a special venture, by special request, for special occasions." The Masters made their initial appearance at Polly Grimes' concerts in California in October and have since been sought for other bookings.

Composed of Lister, Rozell, J.D. Sumner, James Blackwood, and Jake Hess, the singing group is a unique combination of five of the nation's most outstanding gospel talent in the last four decades. All of them have emphatically stated that it is a strictly a part-time vocation that they enjoy, but they do not consider The Masters an organized quartet seeking full-time engagements.

After a two-year "retirement," Lister reorganized The Statesmen, one of the most sensational quartets in the history of gospel music, three years ago; and has worked diligently to present gospel music "that the people will enjoy in the Statesmen tradition."

The Statesmen had two albums released in 1980, have another release planned for this month, and another album due about July.


# Whats Happening


