



5 egg whites, stiffly beaten

Cream margarine and shortening. Add sugar and beat until mixture is smooth. Add egg yolks and beat well. Combine flour and soda and add to creamed mixture alternating with buttermilk. Stir in vanilla. Add coconut and chopped nuts. Fold in stiffly beaten egg whites. Pour batter into three greased and floured 8" cake pans. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes.

1 8-oz. pkg. cream cheese, softened

1/2 stick margarine

1 box powdered sugar

1 tsp. vanilla


