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

# 1797 Kentucky Land Grants South of Green River [continued]

### Transcribed by Gail Jackson Miller, CG 425 Midcrest Drive Bowling Green, KY 42101

The Land Grants South of Green River are contained in 29 books and comprise 15,730 separate grants. They were granted between 1797 and 1866. The grants, sometimes called "Headright Claims" were based on an Act of Kentucky General Assembly dated 21 Dec 1795. Until 1797, no person could enter a survey within this area except a soldier. The 1797 Act of the General Assembly opened up the vacant lands in this area to any person possessed of family and over 21 years old. Such person were entitled to not less than 100 acres and not more than 200 acres. They had to have lived on the land for one year before they came into actual possession. The surveys upon which these grants are based are recorded in 18 books in the Kentucky Land Office. The following are the first recorded in Volume 1 of these grants. They were transcribed from the filmed original Grants South of Green River, Vol. 1, 1797-1803, FHL film 0272828.

Take a tablespoonfull 2 or 3 times a day.

Boil Black gum bark, red oak bark, dewberry brier root, dog fennel together. If you cannot get dog fennel--make with it. Put what you can hold in your hand good of each. Boil spice and spice cloves, Cinamon Bark together and Strain it all. Mix and put in a bottle. Good for Flux or any Bowell Troubles. This is sure good medicine for we have tried it and know it to be good.

Jones, Murray M., Private, G Co, 39 yrs, 15 Sep 1861 at Camp Caloway, KY. Jan-Feb 1862 sick at Columbia, TN. May-Jun 1862 sick at Hamburg, TN. Discharged 12 Jul 1862 due to disability. Discharge certificate states disability due to paralysis of sphincter muscle of the urethra with anterior curvature of the spine. At discharge was 6 ft 3 in, fair complexion, blue eyes, gray hair, farmer and born Edmonson Co., KY.

Jones, Richard T. F., Private, A Co, 18 yrs, 11 Sep 1861 at Calhoun, KY. May-Jun 1862 sick at Post Hospital Corinth, MS. 5 Aug 1864 sick at Marietta, GA. Discharged 17 Dec 1864 at Bowling Green, KY.

Jones, Russell, Private, D Co, 42 yrs, 14 Sep 1861 at Rochester, KY. Wounded (severely) at the Battle of Stone's River (Murfreesboro, TN) on 31 Dec 1862. Sent to West End General Hospital Cincinnati, OH on 22 Jan 1863. Discharged 14 Mar 1863 at Cincinnati, OH due to disability. Discharge certificate states disability due to gunshot wounds to right hand resulting in loss of use of right hand. Karn, Jacob L. (or Joseph L.), Private, H Co, 21 yrs, 22 Oct 1861 at South Carrollton, KY. Wounded (slightly) at Battle of Stone's River on 2 Jan 1863. Discharged 23 Apr 1863 at Bowling Green, KY due to disability. Discharge certificate states disability due to stiffness of right ankle and foot due to gunshot wounds (ball passed through right foot near the ankle).


Keith, Wade, Private, C Co, 27 yrs, 10 Sep 1861 at Rochester, KY. Deserted 8 Apr 1862 at Shiloh, TN and returned to regiment on 20 Apr 1862. May-June 1862 sick at Evansville, IN. 30 Apr-31 Aug 1862 AWOL, (notation of "worthless and not fit for anything") Deserted 8 Sep 1862. Returned to regiment 20 Apr 1863. Deserted 10 Jul 1863 and returned 25 Jul 1863. Restored to duty by order of General Burnside with loss of all pay until 1 Sep 1863. Deserted on 13 Feb 1864 at Richmond, KY on the march to Mt. Sterling, KY. 24 Feb 1864 under arrest for desertion. Confined in stockade at Mt. Sterling, KY Mar-Aug 1864. Court-martialed Aug 1864 for desertion and being drunk and disorderly. Sep 1864 restored to duty with loss of pay and allowances for two months. Discharged 16 dec 1864 at Bowling Green, KY. Adjutant General Office memorandum of 16 Jan 1890 removed desertion charges from record, but charges were not expunged from record.

Kelly, Jonathan L., 2<sup>nd</sup> Corporal, F Co, 21 yrs, 21 Oct 1861 at Rochester, KY. Detached service at Altoona, GA May-Jun 1864. Discharged 14 Dec 1864 at Bowling Green, KY.

Kelly, Michael, Private, E Co, 19 yrs, 18 Sep 1861 at Brownsville, KY. Jul-Aug 1862 with wagon train at Bowling Green, KY. Captured at Battle of Stone's River on 31 Dec 1862 and sent to Belle Island Prison, Richmond, VA on 15 Jan 1863. Paroled at City Point, VA on 20 Jan 1863 and reported to Camp Chase, OH on 10 Mar 1863 and reported 13 Mar 1863. Exchanged May 1863 and returned to regiment. Mar-Apr 1864 sick at Camp Nelson, KY. Discharged 16 Dec 1864 at Bowling Green, KY.

**Kennedy**, **Robert T.**, 1<sup>st</sup> Sergeant, I Co, 29 yrs, 21 Sep 1861 at Camp Caloway, KY. Commissioned as 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant (vice **Columbus Neal**, resigned) on 17 Mar 1863 at Bowling Green, KY. Promoted to 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant (vice **James R. Wise**, promoted) on 1 Jun 1863 at Carthage, TN. Sep 1863-May 1864 on extended leave to Illinois. Resigned 16 Jun 1864 to accept a civil position in state of Illinois where he resides.
