

The National Quartet Convention was reorganized at a meeting held in Nashville in December of 1981, with a Board of Directors being formed to operate the prestious event.

The new Board of Directors which will oversee the 26th Annual National Quartet Convention consists of J. G. Whitfield, president; Brock Speer, secretary/treasurer; Les Beasley, Glen Payne, Rex Nelon, Claude Hopper, Charlie Burke and Don Shumate.

The board represents years of experience and in the involvement of gospel music and these industry leaders have pledged 100 percent support to the National Quartet Convention with the pledge to make future conventions bigger and better.

The attendance at the 1981 convention was the biggest in recent years, which reflects the current trend of popularity of tradition, southern gospel quartet music.







# Hemphills Go To England

The International Silk Cut Festival of Country Music took it's first gospel group to London this year, and their choice was the Hemphills.

The famous Wembley Arena has held overflow crowds annually for the past fourteen years and has featured the greatest gathering of country music stars outside the U.S.A. Among the line-up this year were such names as Kris Kristofferson, Mell Tillis, Marty Robbins, Terri Gibbs, Don Williams, Roy Orbison,

and many more. Also included with the Hemphills were gospel artists Cynthia Clawson, Jeannie C. Riley and Marijohn Wilkins.

The festival ran four exciting nights with gospel receiving its full share of the audience response.
