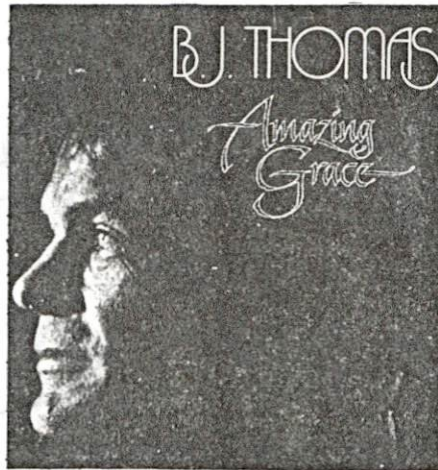
The National Quartet Convention was reorganized at a meeting held in Nashville in December of 1981, with a Board of Directors being formed to operate the prestigious event.

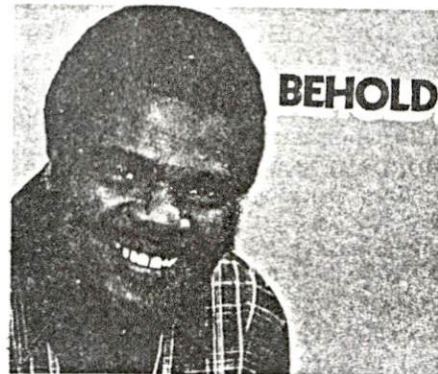
