 3 cups crushed Vanilla wafers
 1/2 cup milk
 1 (4 oz) can Angel Flake coconut
 1 cup chopped walnuts

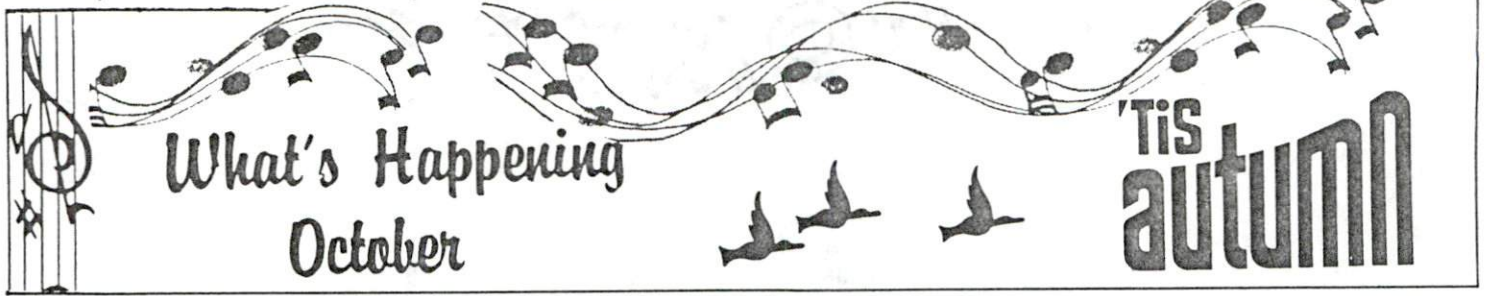

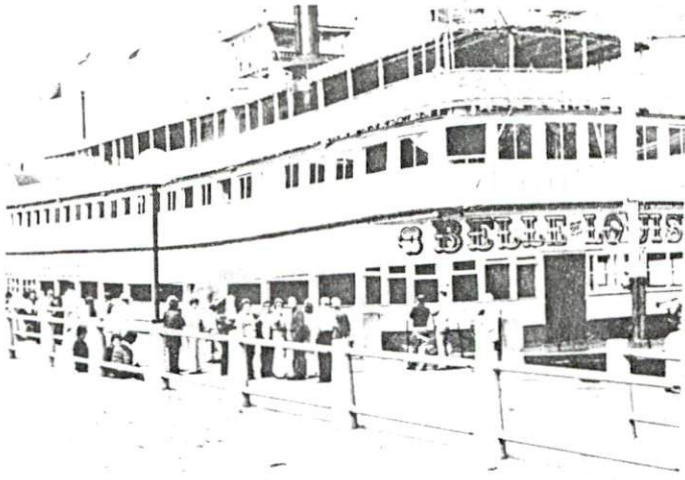

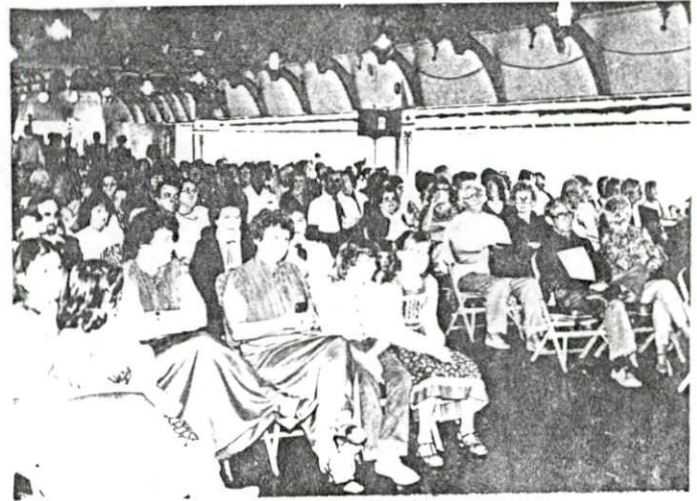
