TITLE OF LEGISLATION: Extended Library Hours

NUMBER: 86-14-S

ACTION TAKEN BY CONGRESS: Passed unanimously

LEGISLATION FORWARDED TO: Dr. Michael Binder, Director of Library Services

DATE FORWARDED: March 27, 1986

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES: Debra Wredman, member of the Student Rights committee, served as student government's liaison to work with Dr. Binder on this matter. Several meetings were held and Mrs. Sally Ann Koenig, Head of Library Public Services, addressed Congress.

RESPONSE FROM ADMINISTRATION: Compromise was reached between this proposal<sup>12</sup> and Resolution 86-18-S. (See attached)

PURPOSE: For the university to extend the library hours of Helm and Cravens Library from 7:45 a.m. to 3:45 a.m. during the weekend prior to and the week of final exams so students who wish to study or research may have that opportunity.

STATUS: **PASSED**

WHEREAS, The library has limited hours, and

WHEREAS, These hours do not meet the needs of the student body during exam week or the weekend before the exam week, and

WHEREAS, Many students would take advantage of this additional educational opportunity, and

WHEREAS, There is no place on campus at present time that meets the needs of the student body during exams, and

WHEREAS, Increased hours of the library during these times would give the student body a good atmosphere for learning besides residence hall rooms,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved that we, the members of the Associated Student Government being duly elected representatives of the student body, do urge the University to open the library from 7:45 a.m. to 3:45 a.m. during the weekend prior to and the week of final exams so the student body may have the additional educational opportunity of the library.
