





Paulette Clardy is attending Nursing School and has only one more year to go. You're almost there. Paulette!


Stewards of the King just purchased some new sound equipment from Dennis Billingsley at Far Out Music. This purchase includes a 16 channel mixer.

- 2 1/4 cups sifted cake flour
- 1 ½ cups sugar
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon.salt
- ¹/₂ cup salad oil
- 3/4 cup (8) egg yolks
- 1 teaspoon grated orange peel
- ³/₄ cup orange juice
- 1 cup (8) egg whites
- ½ teaspoon cream of tarter 1 - 3 - ½ ounce can flaked coconut

Sift dry ingredients together into bowl make well in center; add in order; salad oil, egg volks, orange peel, orange juice. Beat till smooth, beat egg whites with cream of tarter till very stiff peaks form. Pour batter in thin stream over entire surface of egg whites. Fold in gently. Fold in coconut. bake in ungreased 10 inch tube pan in slow oven (325) about 55 minutes; invert to cool

Bonnie, Ernest and Nancy Jaggers, Eddie and Nancy Waddle and family, part of The Stewards of the King, Dennis Billingsley of Far Out Music, Jeffersonville, Ind., and the Caverna Cheerleaders who provided concessions stay to clean up the Bale Tobacco Warehouse. A truck load of speakers, amps, microphones, and cords and cords and cords must be loaded to return to Jeffersonville. Ind. Chairs have to loaded onto trucks to be returned to Stearman's Funeral Home, Cub Run School and Memorial School. The Caverna Cheerleaders have to stay and clean up all the trash left over from the sale of concessions.

Monday night some of the same group spend several hours taking down the stage back drop, loading the lumber, folding sheets, loading lights, folding tarps, winding up cords. The piano must be returned to Caverna School. This is just a small list of work that must be done to make a two night singing at the Bale Tobacco Warehouse possible. Months before, plans were made, numerous telephone calls had to be made, news releases sent to local papers, T.V. and radio stations, and letters sent to groups inviting them. Prayers have been answered because some people cared enough to devote their time and talents, because of their love for Gospel Music.

One disappointing note, according to tickets given away at the door for free door prizes, over 900 people attended the singings. Total offering was \$401.00. This averages to 44 cents per person. I'm asking "Is this going to keep Gospel Music in its rightful place in society?" If this was any other type of program with this amount of talent, tickets would cost \$4.00-\$12.00 per person.

Our goal/aim is that people could come and bring their entire families and enjoy an evening of Gospel Music.



When we start dividing \$400 between the number of groups that sang, this comes out to less than \$20 per group. This will not nearly pay for the gasoline for some groups who travelled long distances to come. Please, help us keep Gospel Music alive.
