(Was voted favorite Male Vocal Singer in 1983 SGMA). The Dixie Echoes was voted favorite Male Group by the SGMA. Dale had hundreds of honors bestowed on him by his peers and his friends. But all of his plaques and awards did not speak as loud as did his own life. Dale was himself, true to himself, his family, and his friends. We miss you now Dale, but we will meet you one day in "Hallelujah Square".

Dale and his wife, Shirley Jean, met and dated all through high school Dale was the only boy she had ever dated. They were married in Columbus, Mississippi in August 9, 1954. Dale and Shirley had two sons, Randy and Andrew. Both boys have sung with Dale in the Dixie Echoes Quartet. Randy is married to the former Paula Vinson, and Andrew is married to the former Brenda Devine. Randy and Paula have one son, Randy Dale, Jr.

Dale leaves his mother, Mrs. Lemmie Shelnut of Adamsville, Alabama, two brothers, Carl M. Shelnut of Adamsville, Alabama and
