Cathedrals featured at NQC

Stephen Speer, Executive Director of the National Quartet Convention, has announced the signing of the Cathedrals to appear 3 nights of the Convention. Speer stated, "On Tuesday, The Cathedrals will be joining 8 other major groups in presenting one of the finest evenings of Southern Gospel Music to be found anywhere. On Thursday, they'll be part of the program preceding the Singing News Fan Awards and chances are, will probably be picking up an award or two later in the evening at the awards presentation. Saturday, The Cathedrals will be part of the big finale evening of the NQC '83. They are one of a small handfull of groups at the top of Southern Gospel Music and we wouldn't dream of having the National Quartet Convention without involving The Cathedrals as much as we could."

GMA meets in Washington, D.C.

Gospel Music Assoc. directors and officers met Thursday, Friday and Saturday, July 21-23, in Washington, D.C. immediately following the annual CBA convention to discuss general business as well as make plans for Gospel Music '84 in Nashville, TN, March 4-7 which culminates each year with the presentation of the Dove Awards.

In addition to again presenting daily seminars and nightly concerts, the GMA week will also include the National Gospel Radio Seminar and Church Music Workshop.

It was reported that the Gospel Music Assoc. in Holland and Great Britain are making progress with additional interest in other European and Far East countries. GMA Holland presented a successful June 18 meeting where more than 10,000 junior choir members expressed interest in joining.

The board also approved the initial investigation for the presentation with local promoters of New Year's Eve dinners and concerts in major U.S. cities where no such event is currently underway.

The International Committee reported an offer by the Israeli government to host a May or June, 1984 board meeting in Israel. The invitation was accepted, while also approving future meetings Oct. 26-28, 1983, in Chicago, Jan. 10-12 in Orlando, FL, as well as involvement in the annual Congretational Breakfast Feb. 1, 1984, and the National Radio Broadcasters convention Jan. 29-Feb. 1, 1984.
