

pupil for disobedience to such rules, or for any contemacy, insubordination or immoral conduct, and have authority to appoint or dismiss all officers and pupils, to require such reports from officers and instructors as it may be necessary, to appoint a treasurer for such schools, and to determine the amount of his bond, which amount shall not be less than \$10,000.00

Upon motion by Regent Cooper, Seconded by Regent Haswell, the local Regent and President Cherry were authorized to investigate the possibility of securing better water facilities and to report at some subsequent meeting of the board, looking towards the installation of same.

Upon motion of Judge Haswell, with a second from Regent Cooper, the purchase of a Ford coupe for the use of President Cherry in the work of the school was authorized.

Inasmuch as it has been indicated that the Grinstead Asphalt Company will probably be in a position to donate the asphalt necessary for a drive on Normal Heights, such action will be heartily approved by the Board.

Upon motion of Regent Cooper with a second from Regent Cuthbertson, it was agreed that the school should erect a shed or drill hall for the R. O. T. C., this building not to exceed in cost \$1,500.00. In case this amount will not cover the cost, the Board will take additional action.

WHEREAS an emergency existed that demanded additional class room space at the beginning of the present semester, the Board approved of the action of the Local Regent and President Cherry in converting the Senior House into a Library and the old Library space into class rooms. They were authorized to pay the expenses incurred in making these changes.

Upon motion of Mr. Cuthbertson seconded by Mr. Cooper, the Treasurer was authorized to borrow for the Board of Regents a sum of money not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), to be used for general expenses of the Western Kentucky State Normal School and Teachers College, this to be repaid from the current taxes collected in December of 1923 and January 1924.

President Cherry nominated the faculty for next year and the Board of Regents approved the same. President Cherry at the next meeting of the Board to submit the complete salary schedule including such changes as may be necessary.

A tribute upon the death of the former Regent Potter was then read and adopted, a copy of it ordered spread on the minute book and a copy sent to Mrs. Potter and to Mr. Julian Potter of New York, wife and son. The following is a copy:

A TRIBUTE TO FORMER REGENT POTTER

Behind every notable achievement stands the work and thought and prayers of those men ordained of God to lead in the progress of His work--such a man was J. Whit Potter, and such service he gave to the Western Normal. During sixteen years, he was its resident Regent. Every inch which the institution has added to its stature was stamped with his thought and ideals.

And we who are now the Regents write in the records that we loved him as a dear friend, and that our labors for the Normal are largely based on the foundation he has laid.

President Cherry was authorized to secure a picture of Mr. Potter for his office.

President Cherry was authorized to issue certificates to those completing the Advanced, Elementary (College), Intermediate (Secondary) and Elementary (Secondary) as recommended by the Dean and Faculty.

Upon motion of Regent Haswell, with a second by Regent Cuthbertson, it was ordered that the bond of the Registrar, should be renewed at the expense of the school.

The Board of Regents endorsed the action of President Cherry concerning the Foundation Fund, which will be known as the College Heights Foundation.

Inasmuch as the school book store is in a position to refund to the State of Kentucky all the money furnished to it at its establishment, it was resolved that this be done and that the store in the future be continued as the Students' Cooperative Store, and that the profits accruing from it hereafter be turned into the College Heights Foundation.

The meeting then adjourned.
