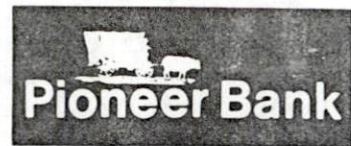

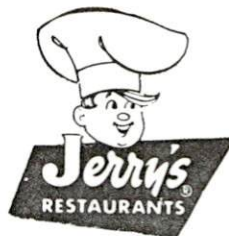

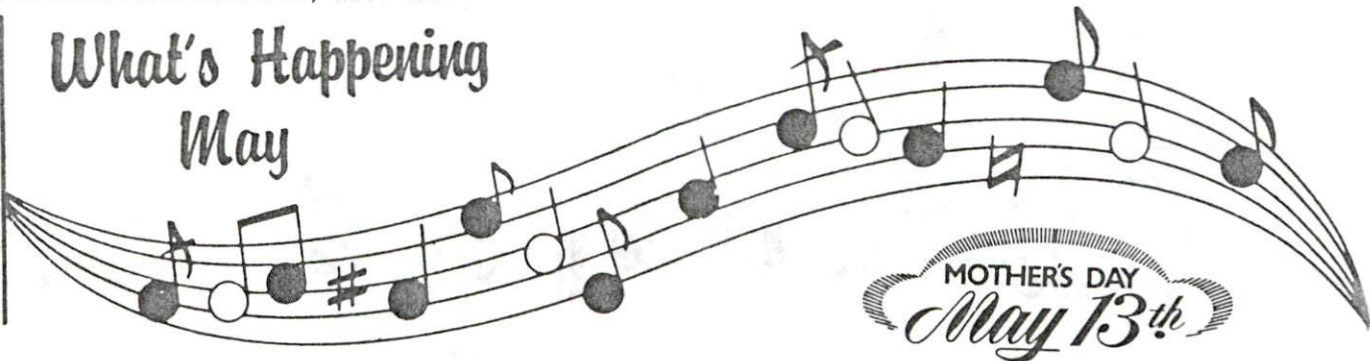

Recipes

STRAWBERRY CAKE

- 1 pkg white Pillsbury cake mix
- 1 pkg strawberry jello small
- 1 cup strawberries
- 1 cup wesson oil
- 4 eggs

Beat all together and bake in 3 small or 2 large layers.

Icing

- 1 box powdered sugar
 - 1/2 cup salt butter
 - 1 cup drained strawberries
- Cream all together and spread on cake. Refrigerate.

MONKEY BREAD

- 4 cans buttermilk biscuits (cut each biscuit into fourths)
 - Shake in 1/2 cup of sugar and 2 tpsps cinnamon.
 - Bring to boil:
 - 3/4 stick of margarine
 - 3/4 cups of sugar
 - 1 tsp. cinnamon
- Dump one half biscuits into greased Bundt pan then add one half of mixture. Add other half of biscuits and other half of mixture. Bake at 350°, 30 to 35 min. Let cool before dumping out. Ready to eat with fingers
