The Strode Family from Lamb, KY, came to Hilltop Studio and recorded their second album, which was released in April on the Jay-Cross label.

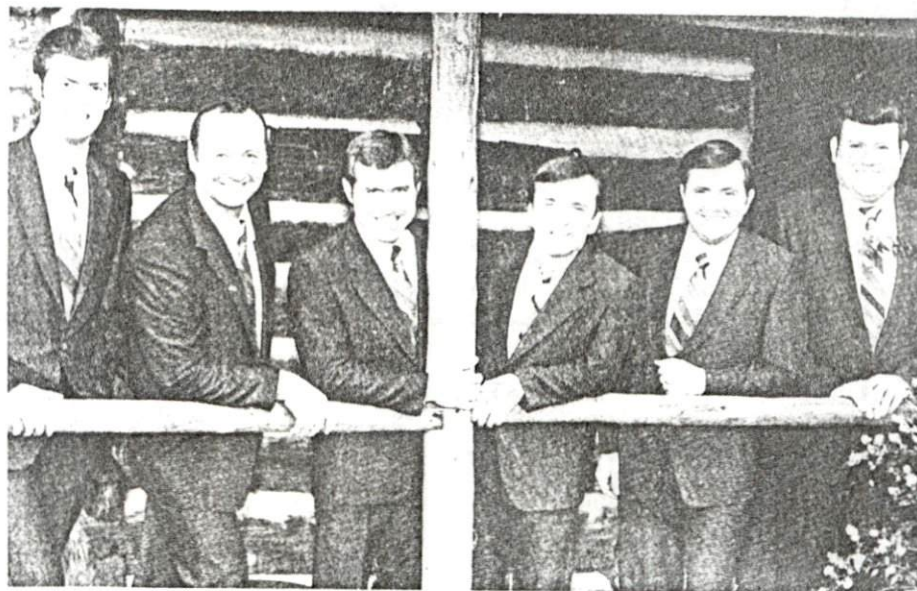

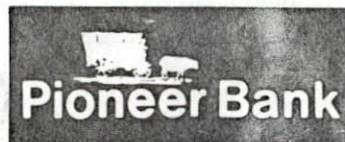

## Recipe

### PINEAPPLE CAKE

- 2 eggs
- 2 tsps. soda
- 1 tsp. vanilla

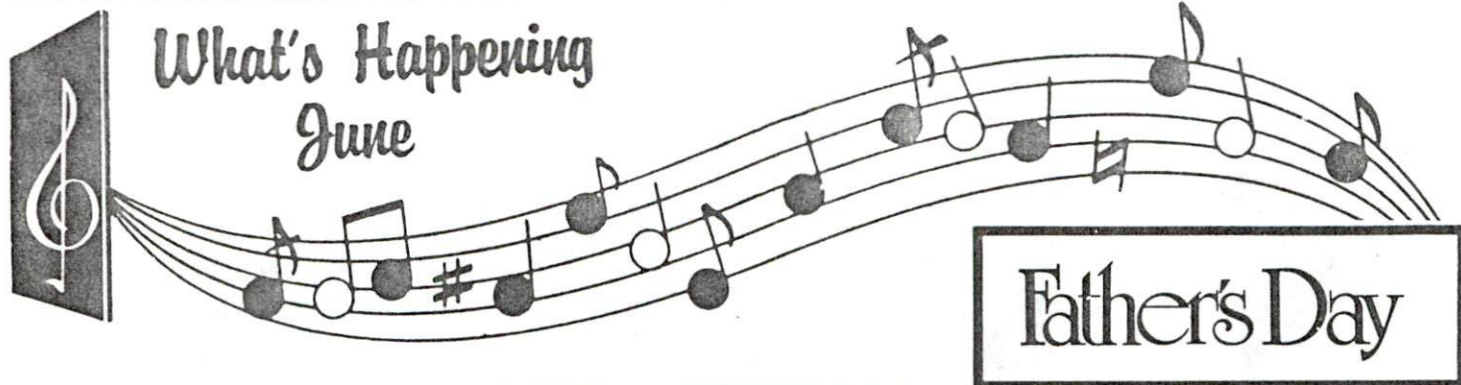

# Radio Seminar successful

NASHVILLE, TN: The National Gospel Radio Seminar is pleased to announce the results of exit interviews with seminar participants. At the closing session registrants completed a questionnaire expressing their views of the seminar value, strengths of NGRS and other topics — including, whether they plan to return in 1985.

Some 68% of those responding ranked the seminar value between 8 and 10, with 10 representing highest value. Some 14.5% ranked it at 10. When asked if the National Gospel Radio Seminar meets a need in their professional growth, 67% of the respondents answered, strongly agree, with another 31% agree and somewhat agree.

The best measurement of any, however, is the final question ... "Do you plan to attend next year". Ninety-one percent of those surveyed said, yes. After a record year for attendance for radio professionals, this kind of response seems to underscore the success of the seminar.

The greatest strength reported by respondents were education and interaction with industry professionals, unity and fellowship.

NGRS Chairman, Jim Black, meeting in New York with the Steering Committee to set the 1985 Seminar

Agenda, expressed great satisfaction with the apparent success.

"The goal of the National Gospel Radio Seminar throughout its fourteen years of existence has been to educate and support Gospel Radio Broadcasters from all over the country", says Black. "It is our desire to help Christian Broadcasters develop in their profession. We are thrilled to see this unity among those from a cross-section of Gospel Radio. From Southern Gospel to Contemporary formats, these men are trying to be the best they can

to glorify the Lord in their work and ministry".

A spokesperson for the NGRS said the 1985 theme will be "Gospel Radio Works". To support this theme promotional announcements will be produced for the use of local stations. These announcements will promote the effectiveness of advertising on Gospel Radio, and will be available at the 1985 convention in Nashville.

Workshops have been planned for management, sales, non-commercial operations, programming and production, offering interaction with top professionals in each discipline.

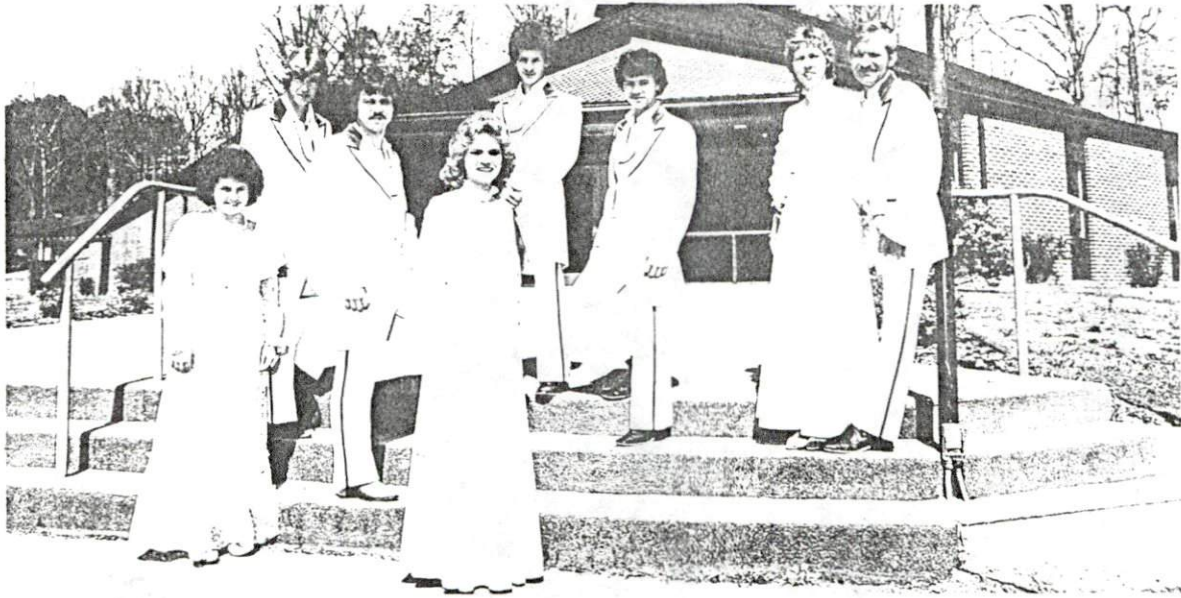

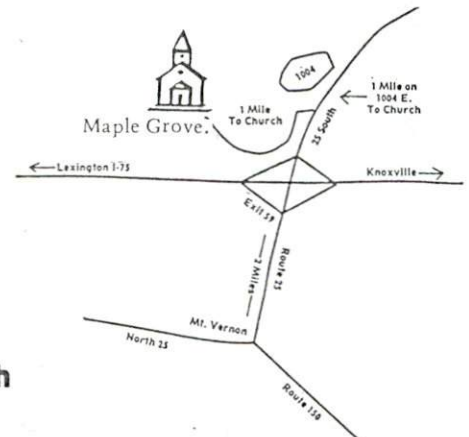
