Resolution 86-33-S
Implementation of Teacher Evaluations for All Semesters
Introduced 4-08-86

THEREFORE, Be it resolved that we, the Associated Student Government, ask the University to continue faculty evaluations and extend it to both Fall and Spring semesters.
