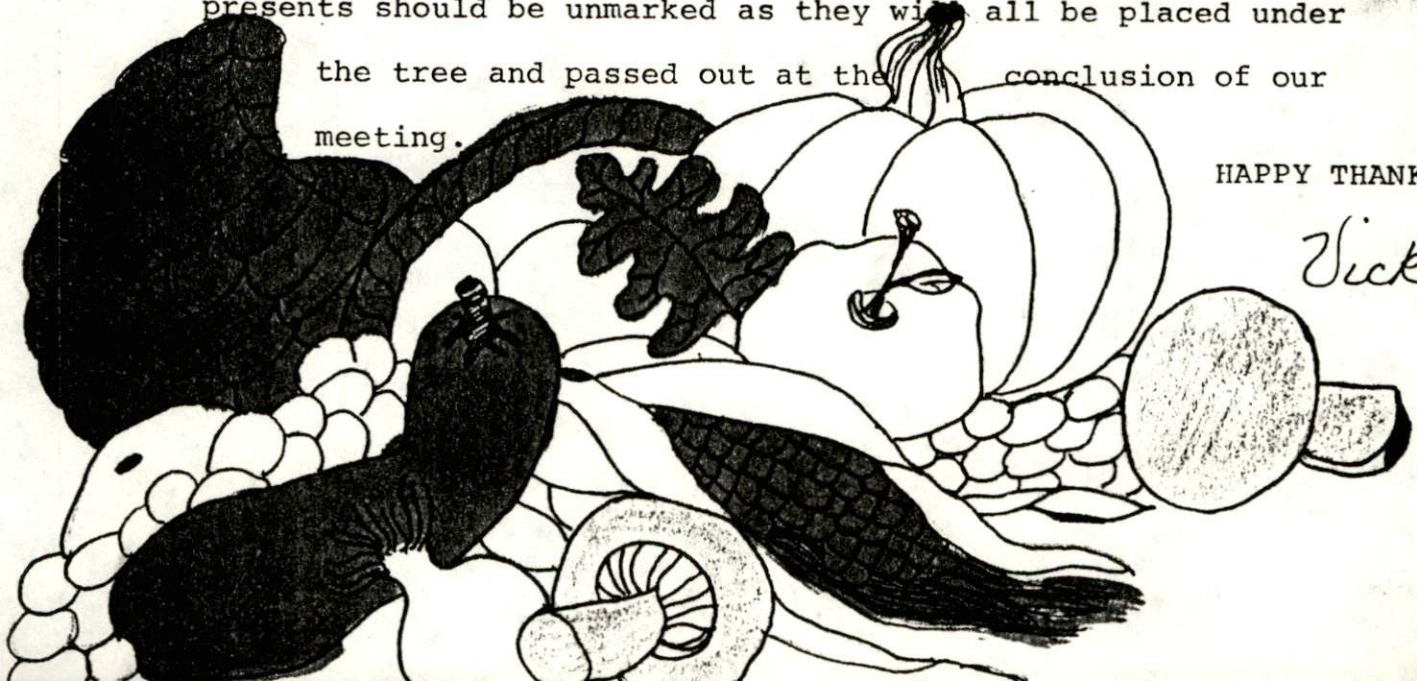
Keep in mind that next month we will be awarding scholarships for the upcoming Spring '81 semester. Carol Hatler is open for any new applications of worthy recipients.
