

SUBJECT: Composition of Faculty Senate V

The Executive Committee has requested that John Long, Parliamentarian of Senate IV, offer the explanation and motion stated below, at the April 30, 1981 meeting of Senate V -- that said motion be presented prior to the elections of senate officers (See Item 3 on the Agenda).

EXPLANATION AND MOTION:

Because of the proposed and expected dissolution of the College of Applied Arts and Health, the expected mergers of departments, and other possible organizational changes; and because of the fact that many of these changes were effected after the senate elections held between February 16 and February 26, 1981, the senate has been left to face the problem of the place and role of the senators elected for Senate V.

To address this problem, the Executive Committee proposes:

That the senate function with the representational composition based on the correct numbers as of the time of the elections -- this to be a temporary measure to last for the duration of Senate V only.
