*** WOMAN OF THE YEAR ***

EACH ABWA CHAPTER SELECTS ONE OF ITS MEMBERS AS THE CHAPTER WOMAN OF THE YEAR. Suggested guidelines are mailed annually from National Headquarters to aid the Woman of the Year Committee in its duties. Throughout the year, recognition is given the chapter Woman of the Year at such special chapter functions as Anniversaries and Enrollment Events. Citations are presented to Women of the Year in attendance at the annual National Convention.

If the chapter Woman of the Year is eligible for consideration in the competition for Top Ten Business Women of ABWA, and wished to compete, she must complete and return the current "Top Ten Business Women of ABWA Candidate Form" to National Headquarters. A panel of non-member judges selects the "Top Ten" and "American Business Woman of the Year," based on the following standards:

1.	Business Experience

2.	Education	3	points
3.	General Information	2	points
4.	ABWA Participation	3	points
	MAXIMUM TOTAL	15	points

The identities of the Top Ten Business Women of ABWA and the "American Business Woman of the Year" are formally announced at the ABWA Annual National Convention.

To be eligible a letter must be submitted on the nominee by another member or members stating her qualifications for being selected the Kentucky Colonel Chapter Woman of the Year. The letters are then read at our chapter meeting; and the membership votes to select the Woman of the Year. If you have someone in mind, be getting your information together. We will be getting further information on format for selection soon. Selection of the Woman of the Year satisfies #4 of the Standard of Achievement

RAMADA INN--Buffet style, two meats, four vegetables, salad, desert, drink. \$5.65


RED CARPET INN--Buffet style, two meats, four vegetables, salad, desert, drink. \$5.50 They will sign a contract for a year.

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*** KENTUCKY COLONEL CHAPTER STANDING LAWS ***

- To receive perfect attendance each member will be given 3 months to make up a meeting; must attend 1 of the 2 Enrollment Events; must attend 1 of the major Ways & Means projects and must attend Boss Night. This is retroactive to June 1, 1979. Law passed August 28, 1979.
