

Minutes of Board Meeting

April 14, 1930.

The Board of Regents met in the office of President Cherry at three o'clock, Monday, April 14th.

There were present Regents M. O. Hughes, Col. Bassett, Judge Harlin, Captain Brinton B. Davis, Architect, and President Cherry.

In the absence of the regular chairman, Mr. Hughes presided. He stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss plans and specifications for the proposed Health Building to be erected on the campus of the State Teachers College as prepared by the Architect, Mr. Brinton B. Davis.

The plans and specifications as prepared by Captain Davis were presented, examined and accepted.

Captain Davis was requested by the Board to advertise in the Louisville and Bowling Green papers for sealed proposals and to assemble these bids and report at the next meeting of the Board to be held in Louisville on the morning of May 9th at ten o'clock at the Seelbach Hotel. All Regents voted in the affirmative.
