WHEREAS one of the critical factors in the establishment and maintenance of acceptable levels of morale is the relative purchasing power of the faculty, and

WHEREAS professionals should have recognized input into a process which affects faculty compensation,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that faculty should be involved in the process which affects their compensation and that the present plan and method for salary compensation is unacceptable. Since faculty input has been excluded, morale will be further eroded.
