COUNCIL OF ACADEMIC DEANS

July 28, 1975

The Council of Academic Deans met on Monday, July 28, 1975, at 11:00 a. m. in the Garrett Conference Center Executive Room. Present were Deans Cravens, Sandefur, Chelf, Mounce, Hardin, Sutton, Hourigan, Gray, Cortis, Russell, Oppitz, and Davis.


Dr. Davis discussed the information the University required to comply with Affirmative Action in the area of faculty recruiting and hiring. (1) Where and when was the position advertised? (2) How many applications were received? (3) What is the status of those applications received from women and minorities? (4) Why is the person being recommended outstanding when compared to other candidates? (5) A statement that the University Affirmative Action Plan has been followed. The deans stated that they would work with their department heads to insure compliance in this matter.

Dr. Cortis commented on a proposal for a Council of Academic Deans Workshop. The decision was made to hold the workshop in early September at Barren River State Park.

Dr. Gray discussed the utilization of 400-level courses in different academic programs. The group decided to have each dean work with his department heads to insure that 400-G courses would not have associate degree students in the same class with graduate students.

The deans discussed the July 26 meeting of the Board of Regents at some length.

The meeting adjourned at 12:55 p. m.
