these Presents sealed with our seals and dated
the 14th day of December 1797

The Condition of the above Obligation
is such that whenever there is a marriage &
shortly intended between the above bound Julian
Phelps and Joannah Jones for which alliance
they stand now if there be no lawful cause to
obstruct the said marriage then this obligation
to be void else to remain in full force and virtue
