Know all men by these Presents that we ¹⁻² Drewry Taylor & Eliza Taylor, are held and fully bound unto his excellency the Governor for the time being the sum of \$40 to which they will and truly to be made to the said Governor This Sufficient and bind ourselves our heirs &c. Jointly and severally fully by these Presents sealed with our seals and dated this 5th day of March 1799.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas there is a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the above bound Drewry Taylor and Jenny Bowles for which a licence has issued now if there be not some cause to obstruct the said marriage then this obligation to be void else to remain in full and verbal
