I know full well by this present that we George  
Elder and William Smith are held and firmly  
firmly bound unto his Excellency the Governor for  
the time being in the sum of £20 which  
payment will and truly be made unto the  
said governor or his Successors we bind ourselves  
our heirs &c Jointly and severally by these  
presents sealed with our seals and Dated this  
the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1800

The condition of the above Obligation is such that  
whenever there is a marriage duly intended to be  
solemnized between the above bound George Elder  
and Becky Ray, for which a license is given  
now if there be no just cause  
to Obstruct the said Marriage then this Obliga-  
tion to be Void Else to remain in full force &  
virtue.
